- Creating a PBIS positive school climate that is safe, respectful, responsible, kind and fosters belonging to all students and staff.
- Implemented CRM, TRAILS and Second Step to help students build social and emotional skills, manage emotions, and establish positive relationships.
- Set and enforce policies. Use a behavior matrix that outlines behavioral expectations.
 Expectations are practiced several times a year.
- Recess is monitored by the teacher and each class has their own recess times.
- Staff received CRM training this year.
- Teachers use a morning and at the end of the day circle time to build positive relationships amongst students and restore any injustices throughout the day.
