[Town of Manchester Ordinances: Chapter 12: Skateboarding Restrictions](#)

12-1: Purpose

“The purpose of this Ordinance is to protect public safety by prohibiting the use of skateboards, or similar wheeled devices (roller skates, roller blades, etc. ..) in the Town’s central business district. Skateboarding, roller skating and roller blading in the commercial core of the Town constitute a nuisance and a threat to pedestrian safety.”

12-3: Prohibited Activities

“Skateboarding, roller skating and roller blading shall be prohibited on all public sidewalks, public highways and private parking lots accessible to the public, which are located in the Town’s CI Zoning District (as defined by the Town’s current Zoning Ordinance).”
