

## **COVID-19 Mitigation Matrix**

Sartell-St. Stephen Schools will use various indicators of COVID-19 transmission levels to determine when District mitigation strategies need to be adjusted (increase or decrease). Data sources include local school district information from Stearns County Public Health as well as school-level information.

<sup>\*</sup>The transmission rate and appropriate response will be determined by the District Administrative COVID-19 Team, in consultation with Stearns County Public Health and local medical providers. This team will conduct a regular review of these indicators, giving weight to the District/School Building-specific data in making the determination. \*In the case of **significantly high transmission** within a classroom or school building <u>or</u> the **inability to appropriately staff** a classroom/building, consideration will be given to temporary distance learning. Decisions will be made on a case-by-case basis.
