A. Amelia

2. Executive Meeting Updates: Two vacancies were filled in the ASBSU Senate by Anahita and Melanie. There is a new vacant position in the Assembly and Melanie and Anahita will work to fill it.
3. Discuss "Engaging Men of Color": Melanie is working on a workshop for students to come and have a conversation about gender norms and biases. Melanie posed to the group that these conversations are useful, but does not know the exact way to go about delivering it. Jeff from Student Equity is very interested in creating this workshop with Melanie. Melanie spoke that the Athletics program may get involved as well. Melanie does not want it to be a firm workshop but more of a casual conversation with a speaker to start the conversation.
4. Discussion: Melanie spoke that several Hispanic Student Organizations want to have Hispanic celebrations in the first week of November.

E. Leo

1. Discussion: Leo has been working on the Body Positivity

workshop, as well as preparing for the ASBSU Constitutional Convention. Leo has also been working with Jason in Student Equity on student housing.
