OVERVIEW

Throughout the semester, you will be doing reading summaries for the following:

- chapters from the *The Design of Everyday Things (DoET)* book, and
- the ten (10) papers that you selected individually from your *References List* assignment.

These summaries will help you in better preparing for your project's design and for writing your Final Report. In this assignment, you will write summaries of these readings by giving an overview and providing a discussion of your insights on those readings. **Word count: at least 200 words.**

Title

Under "Title", replace "..." inside the parentheses with the reading (e.g., "DoET Ch. 5-6", "Paper 7").

References

Put the reference's BibTeX code in "references.bib". If you do not have the BibTeX code for that reference, then create it manually and auto-generate it from the website below:

Author List

Under "Author List", replace "Firstname Lastname" with your name.

Abstract

Under “Abstract”, put the name of the book and chapter (DoET) or paper (Literature Review). At the end of the name, add the citation using “~\cite{...}”.

Overview

DoET only

Under “Overview”, write a paragraph (at least 5-6 sentences) that covers the key points of the chapter.

Literature Review only

Under “Overview”, write a paragraph (at least 5-6 sentences) containing your first sentence that summarizes the paper that you have selected. The overview must contain the following contents:

- Current Context: The background information of the domain.
- Problem Statement: The stated problem.
- Proposed Solution: The proposed solution.
- Solution Details: Additional details of the solution.
- Evaluation Summary: Overview of how the authors evaluated their solution,.
- Claimed Contribution: The claimed contributions of the solution.

Discussion

DoET only

Under “Discussion”, write a short paragraph (about 5-6 sentences) discussing your thoughts about the reading.

The discussion must contain the following contents:

- Personal Opinion: Your thoughts of the key concepts in the chapter.
- Real-World Example: An explanation of a real-world example that you experienced or know of that directly relates to one of the key concepts discussed in the chapter.
- Corresponding Image: An image that corresponds to your real-world example.

Literature Review only

Under “Discussion”, write a short paragraph (about 5-6 sentences) discussing your thoughts about the reading.

The discussion must contain the following contents:

- Agree: What you liked about the paper.
- Negatives: What you did not like about the paper.
- Relevance: How relevant this paper is to your project.
