# 4. Minutes of meeting

## Risk Management

Juanjo announced a new strategy on Dec,5

This will be based on the following resources:

- <u>Dissemination events log</u> (delegated to Nuria)
- Leaders' karma (managed by TID)
- GEri karma (managed by TID)

Note that karma can negative or positive. Good performers will score high.

#### From Juanjo's message:

"It will be based on scores, a GE owner or the lead/architect/group leader will have a "karma" that expresses the situation and performance in relation with the risks. Please note that there is a direct link between the "empowerment" of the GE owners with the karma status. Those with a good performance will remain trusted and free to act autonomously whereas those with a bad "karma" will be monitored and subject to reviews. "

"Eventually, more serious decisions will be taken. As an example, it doesn't make sense that someone leads or play the role of architect in a group if his/her performance has proven to be rather bad during a long period, so better to run an election of a new lead/architect. Besides, there is no reason to accept reported costs in FI-Core about an activity as chapter/wg leader or chapter/architect if the appointed person doesn't work. This is the way to let work those who are doing well while not impacting our image





because of those who are doing not so well."

"This process will also apply to assessment of TID coordination responsibilities, of course. Here, any of the chapter/wg leaders and chapter architects will be entitled to ask for lowering or increasing the karma of any person involved in coordination activities from TID whenever (s)he beleives it would be fair and there are no disagreements from the rest of chapter/wg leaders and chapter architects."

Pascal asks to have earlier notice of the events.

Pascal asks to get info from past events (for instance, those posted in basecamp)

Pascal suggests to add internal events (for instance meeting business people at Thales). Miguel disagrees because this out of the scope of the work we intend to do with this.

Philipp asks for a rough table of possible causes/scores. Miguel suggestion is to provide an example in the short term (not a final solution but at least quick and dirty sketch)

Juanjo sent an email elaborating on the status of several sections. Major weakness in Advanced Web-based UI chapter. A recommendation was made to merge contents of the store linked to open data and the section dealing with publication of open data.

#### Following is a revision of the planning (to be reviewed in this meeting):

- Nov 4th -> Nov 7th: assignments of responsible of sections (linked to scenarios): responsible (Juanjo) - Done
- Nov 10th -> Nov 21th (partial but major components) -> ???? (complete): a first take of sections (may be not all but all those necessary to have a relatively complete view of FIWARE): people taking care of each section
- Nov 10th -> Nov 13th (first take) -> Nov 21th (final): basic design on how contents will be embedded on the websites (fiware.org and catalogue.fiware.org): Ogilvy Done
- Nov 14th -> Nov 27th: 1st take of contents integrated on websites in progress

In addition to uploading contents on the website, we have to cope with producing and sending the formal deliverable. This will be produced beginning of next week.

A little bit of delay but all progressing and doing work with Ogilvy.





We need to close this soon, we have a meeting with the accelerators. Juanjo ask Philipp to push his part as it is lagging behind. Thursday is the goal but Philipp sees it as "very challenging". Juanjo asks to at least concentrate on the introduction and then the "how-to"s could be dealt with later on. To have something to link when people click on the links. Phillips agrees then to have something for Thursday.

Davide is in discussions with Ogilvy to see how to organize the landing page of the FIWARE Catalogue (http://catalogue.fiware.org). Juanjo: shouldn't we address the creation of sections dealing with Incubated GEs, FIWARE-based domain-Specific Enablers, FIWARE GEris, alternative FIWARE GEis ... Davide: shouldn't we define tags for each of these categories that can be assigned to each entry? The landing page should allow to browse on enablers just based on supported features and allow that for a given set of features, all incubated GEs, FIWARE GEris, alternative FIWARE GEis and FIWARE-based Domain-specific enablers are listed.

Milestones: design of FIWARE Catalogue home page (December 1st) - (AP or Davide created in previous meetings)

# Status of coaching activities and support to evaluation of Open Calls published by FIWARE Accelerator projects (SKIPPED)

Update on Dec, 11: we skip this section and leave it for future reference

Stefano: Some of the FIWARE Accelerator projects are completely expecting support from FIWARE experts regarding evalution of the "Relevance to FIWARE" criteria while some others have arranged the hiring of independent evaluators to carry out the evaluation of such criteria. The EC has stated that if evaluators are provided by the projects, then they have to be trained and "approved" by FIWARE.

It was agreed to have a confcall tomorrow morning because we need to come with a concrete proposal to the meeting with FIWARE Accelerator projects that will take place in Coimbra this Thursday-Friday.

Some possible discussion points for tomorrow:

- Do external evaluators need to be approved by FI-WARE? (especially the ones that claim FIWARE expertise). If so how?
- Are the trainings in bootcamps enough to make external evaluators knowledgeable enough to evaluate FIWARE criteria? or do they need some additional tips (such as just deployment on FIWARE, or usage of only IDM is not sufficient etc..)
- Do we still need an approval mechanism for evaluators trained in bootcamps?
- At what point should the coaches be involved for the projects that seems to have planned their evaluation process in great detail and recruited external evaluators?
- What is the best way to get clarification on coaching related issues? is the mailing list the





only tool? should we have some periodic calls, etc?
