

2024-2025 Clear Creek School District Preschool Tuition Menu

Please see the chart below for information regarding the 2024-2025 Preschool Tuition Rate and the associated “stackable” funding stream options.

Base Tuition Rates:	4 days a week: tuition \$805 per month	2 days a week: tuition \$402.50 per month
<u>Cost for 4 year olds</u>		
Tuition Option 4-1:	4 days a week of preschool: Cost: \$402.50 per month of tuition + 2 days FREE (UPK funded 15 hour match required)	
Tuition Option 4-2:	2 days a week of preschool: Cost: FREE (UPK funded 15 hour match required)	
Tuition Option 4-3:	4 days a week of preschool AND qualified for UPK 30 hour: Cost: FREE (UPK funded 30 hour match required)	
Tuition Option 4-4:	Students who are 4 AND have an IEP will receive 4 days a week of FREE preschool. Cost: FREE (UPK 15 hour match required + Special Education funding)	
<u>Cost for 3 year olds</u>		
Tuition Option 3-1:	4 days a week of preschool: Cost: \$805 per month of tuition	
Tuition Option 3-2:	2 days a week of preschool: Cost: \$402.50 per month of preschool	
Tuition Option 3-3:	Students who are 3 AND have an IEP will receive 2 days a week of FREE preschool. Cost: FREE (Special Education funding)	
Tuition Option 3-4	Students who are 3 AND have an IEP will receive 2 days a week of FREE preschool. Cost: \$402.50 per month of tuition +Special Education funding	
Tuition Option 3-5	Students who are 3 AND have an IEP AND qualified for UPK funded 10 hours a week will receive 3.5 days a week of FREE preschool. Cost: \$135 per month of tuition** + Special Education Funding + UPK funding (UPK 10 hour funding match required)	
<u>Cost for 5 year olds who are kindergarten age eligible</u>		
Tuition Option 5-1:	4 days week of preschool Cost: tuition \$805 per month	
Tuition Option 5-2:	2 days a week of preschool Cost: tuition \$402.50 per month	

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Students with an IEP who are aged 5-7 in preschool per their IEP		
Tuition Option 6-1:	Cost: to be determined in coordination with the special education team and Mt. Evans BOCES AU.	Cost: to be determined in coordination with the special education team and Mt. Evans BOCES AU.

Stackable funding: depending on the option above that families choose or are eligible for, they can pay for preschool by stacking their available funding streams. (e.g. UPK + IDEA + CCAP+ family out of pocket OR other derivations thereof)

Just the above will be put on the website for the 23-24 school year.

A consideration for the future:

Early Childhood Education and Care is of vital importance to the families that we serve. Owing to that, CCSD may want to consider implementing a [graduated tuition schedule](#) in the future. There are several contributing factors that may impact the need for such a schedule. They are: the implementation of the state’s Universal Preschool Program, preschool enrollment, state and county economic futures, the cost of preschool services and operations, and needed staffing numbers and associated salaries. As overall costs increase, tuition rates will likely need to follow suit. Within that systemic change process, should CCSD adopt the use of a graduated schedule(which is based on total household income levels, that change would provide additional equity and access to our families across our service area. Hence affording more families more access to preschool services for their children aged three and four.

Research would need to be performed in order to align a CC graduated schedule to county household income data.
