Brief Description of Entry: _____

Execution: 60 possible points

- Workmanship:
 - Quality of twist (Is the twist consistent throughout? Is the yarn balanced? Is it underspun or overspun with relation to its intended purpose?)
 - Uniformity of weight (Is the thickness consistent throughout?)
 - Strength and hand of finished yarn (Is the yarn appropriate for the fiber used? Is is appropriate for its intended use?)
- Authenticity: Is this a yarn that would have been made and used in period?
- Presentation: overall effect (Is the skein well-made and appropriately tied? Is a sample of the unspun fiber provided? Is a sample of the intended finished use provided?)

Complexity/Difficulty: 25 possible points

- Scope of project:
 - Type of fiber
 - Method of spinning used
 - Preparation of fibers (Did the spinner prepare the fibers?)
 - Gauge (Is the gauge of the yarn consistent and appropriate to its intended use?)
 - Finishing (Was the yarn finished appropriately for the intended use?)
 - Quantity (Is there enough yarn for its intended use?)

Complexity/Difficulty Points: _____

- Basic questions answered (Who? What? When? Where? How?)
- Explanation of item and process; techniques and methods used; reasons for deviation from period method or style; what is the intended use of this yarn?
- Sources and Bibliography (number used, quality); copies of period examples
