Section 3: Dues

Article IV: Officers

- President: The President shall preside over meetings, represent the club at official functions, and act as the chief executive officer.

- Treasurer: The Treasurer shall manage the club's funds and financial records.

Section 2: Election of Officers

Article V: Meetings

The club shall have a faculty advisor who is a member of the University Pathways Public Service Academy staff and who will provide guidance and support to the club.

Section 3: Collaboration with ASB

The club must work in collaboration with the Associated Student Body (ASB) to ensure all activities and events are properly coordinated and approved.

Article IX: Dissolution

Section 1: Procedure

The club may be dissolved by a two-thirds vote of the members, provided that notice of the proposed dissolution has been given at least one week in advance.
