Let's make a logo! But first, some light reading:

Designing a logo is all about the details. Please answer as many questions as you can:

The logo

- What words or letters do you want included in your logo?

- Explain what your company / organization is and does.
 Fantasy Football team
- How are you different than your competition?
 Would like to actually have unique name and logo instead of same boring puns and photoshop.
- What are the benefits of your product/service?
 Nothing
- What attributes of your business / organization would you like your logo to reflect?
 A sense of humor
- How do you intend to market your company?
 Prominently displayed on future designed uniforms, league web page, and logo spot of ESPN fantasy football website.

Goals and Objectives:

- What do you want to happen as a result of this project?
 Get other people in the league to take time trying to make their teams feel more unique and make the league more fun and engaging.
- Identify long-term and short-term objectives.
 Add to league uniqueness, get people more involved in standing out in the league, and creating a longer lasting, more enjoyable sense of competitiveness throughout the participants.

Describe what you want designed:

I'm basically just looking for a logo for a fantasy football team to be designed. The logo you'd see used on websites, helmets, jerseys, etc.

I am not good with background color tones that match. Essentially, the color palette for what would be the team "colors" would be more or less up to you. I'm thinking something very akin to the actual colors that the Boo-Berry box of cereal uses, but very open to other colors and combinations.

I'd like the font for the writing to look somewhat paranormal and maybe close to the Boo-Berry cereal font.

For the actual logo, I want to play on the cross of "Buffalo Bill" from Silence of the Lambs and the Boo-Berry cereal mascot. Our league has a theme of Cereal Killers this year, and I think it's a good punny mix. Design wise, I was thinking Boo-Berry in an open bathrobe putting on some lipstick with his lips pursed. Essentially, looking like Buffalo Bill during the "Goodbye Horses" scene from Silence of the Lambs.

I'd like to have the Buffalo Booberries text prominent, but with Boo kind of leaning or passing through it.
