In order to reach goal The New Mexico Department of Health announced a \$100 incentive for New Mexicans who complete their vaccination series or receive a single-shot Johnson & Johnson vaccination through June 17, and the Vax 2 the Max sweepstakes, which includes a total of \$10 million in cash prizes and other awards to individuals who've already received their vaccination.
