Uniqueness of the College

Government Degree College, Eluru was established in 2008. Since its inception, it started functioning in the buildings shared by Govt. Junior College, Eluru and Municipal High School for Boys, Eluru. There used to be a Shift system, as an interim arrangement, between Govt Jr College and Govt Degree College to accommodate the students of both the colleges. But, from the year 2020, both the colleges started functioning in both the shifts and the rooms hitherto being shared by Govt Jr College have not been shared to the Degree College due to their requirement of classrooms. So, classrooms became so problematic to the Degree College.

- To address the problem of lack of land and own building, Principal of the college, with the support of staff, have relentlessly pursued and finally all these efforts resulted in District Collector and Magistrate issuing advance position of 3.35 acres of land earmarking 1.00 acre for construction of classrooms and labs. - The college utilizing its own resources and mobilizing external resources to see that students would get minimal basic infrastructural facilities. In this connection, the college with the help of LIONS Club, Rotary Club, Inner Wheel and other local philanthropists could acquire some infrastructural facilities such as RO Water Plant, Iron Almirahs, Dual desks etc... which are some of the achievements of the College administration.
- Despite the problem in infrastructure and lacking classrooms, the college could get 79% of admissions against the sanctioned strength in the online admissions which reflects the strength of academic work going on in the college.
