

Fourth Grade Supply List **2026-2027**

A few suggested supplies that you may bring to school if you would like to.....

Students will need **ONE** plastic pencil bag or pencil box (please no cloth) to keep writing utensil supplies in, if bringing any of the below writing items. Each child will have a plastic bin to store all other supplies. Plastic will be easier to sanitize quickly.

- one of each color pocket folder (no tabs or anything else necessary) **RED** (Reading), **YELLOW** (Writing), **GREEN** (Social Studies), **BLUE** (Math), **PURPLE** (Word Study), your choice (Science)
- 6 wide ruled spiral notebooks, colors related to the pocket folder colors
- *****1 ½ inch (one and a half inch) binder with clear view pocket front:** this will be used daily from day one. It is our HOME communication binder.
- pencils (they use a lot this year)
- eraser tops or small pink eraser
- colored pencils (4th graders prefer over crayons for most projects)
- markers (eight is fine, Crayola SuperTips if you want more of a selection)
- scissors
- glue sticks (students will go through several)
- crayons (24 would be fine)
- Kleenex (extra boxes are always appreciated)
- dry erase marker and eraser (the students use them **all year**)
- highlighters (used regularly/yellow is best)



***Put your name on your plastic supply container and folders/notebooks. Please limit the supplies to those on this list. ***The list of supplies is just a suggestion. The supplies are not required. Some students like to have their own personal items.
