Dear 2023-24 Medea Creek NJHS Candidate.

Membership in the National Junior Honor Society (NJHS) is one of the highest honors that can be awarded to a middle-school student. Our chapter shall strive to bring the accomplishments of outstanding students to the attention of parents, teachers, peers, and the community. Our chapter shall strive to give practical meaning to the Society's standards of scholarship, service, leadership, character, and citizenship. These five ideals are considered as the basis for selection. Unlike CJSF, no student is inducted simply because of a high academic average. The National Junior Honor Society strives to recognize the total student—one who excels in all of these areas. The standards used for selection are:

Scholarship: 3.75 cumulative average (<u>current 8th graders this year only</u> can have a 3.5 cumulative average just to continue the CJSF rules previously installed)
Leadership, service, character, and citizenship: as demonstrated by activities and teacher evaluations

Membership, however, is more than an honor. It is an ongoing responsibility and an obligation to continue to demonstrate those outstanding qualities that result in a student's selection. Membership also carries a responsibility to the chapter. If our Medea Creek NJHS chapter is to be effective and meaningful, each member must become involved.

- Meeting attendance required (first Thursday of each month in G-5)
- 10 service hours per semester: there will be two deadlines; January 16 for the first 10 and the final one in early May
  - Students must select from the online pre-approved list or seek prior approval.
     This will always be posted online and updated.
  - Please note that service hours logged for the NJHS cannot be used for any other on-campus organization (ASB, WEB, etc). In other words, you cannot "double dip."
- Participate in our chapter's service group project(s): to be coordinated by students
- Participate in our chapter's fundraising efforts
- Pay a required \$5 yearly membership fee: Check payable to MCMS NJHS
  - This fee covers our school membership and awards/certificates
- Adhere to all due dates/deadlines, with the understanding that are no late submissions
- Utilize our NJHS Google Classroom regularly



Any member who falls below the standards of scholarship, service, leadership, character, or citizenship may be considered for discipline or dismissal from the Medea Creek chapter of the National Junior Honor Society.

We hope you will submit your candidate information packet so that the faculty council can evaluate your candidacy. Congratulations on your success thus far.

## NJHS at Medea Creek Middle School

## **Selection Procedure Description**

The National Junior Honor Society chapter of Medea Creek Middle School is a duly chartered and affiliated chapter of this prestigious national organization. Membership is open to those students who meet the required standards in five areas of evaluation: scholarship, service, leadership, character, and citizenship. Students are selected for membership by majority vote of our faculty council, including Mrs. Stein and Ms. Lavigna, which bestows this honor upon qualified students on behalf of the faculty of our school each fall/spring, depending on grade level.

Students in grades seven and eight are eligible for membership. For the scholarship criterion, a student must have a cumulative GPA of 3.75 or better on a 4.0 scale and no N's or U's. Each fall, those students who meet this criterion are invited to complete a Candidate Application Packet that provides the faculty council with information regarding the candidate's leadership and service.

To assess a candidate's leadership, the faculty council evaluates leadership roles.

To assess a candidate's service, the faculty council evaluates 10 hours of documented service-learning hours (see application packet).

To evaluate a candidate's character, the faculty council uses two forms of input. First, school disciplinary records are reviewed. Second, members of the faculty are solicited for input regarding their professional reflections on a candidate's service activities, character, and leadership.

All Candidate Application Packets are carefully reviewed by the faculty council to determine membership.

A majority vote of the council is necessary for selection. Candidates are notified regarding selection or non selection.

Following notification, a formal induction ceremony is held at school to recognize all the newly selected members. Once inducted, new members are required to maintain the same level of performance (or better) in all four criteria that led to their selection. When the information becomes available, dates will be posted online and in Google Classroom.

Information awareness/deadlines are the responsibility of the applying student, not the parent.
