NCEA CAAs

This year our year 10 cohort is participating in the Term 4 literacy and numeracy pilot CAAs. This is one of the changes NZQA is making to the NCEAs and will be compulsory from 2024.

CAAs are Common Assessment Activities. They are exam-like assessments that students sit at school, are completed digitally, and will be part of many courses from 2024, not just literacy and numeracy. CAAs will be offered in late term 2 and early term 4 from next year onwards. The literacy and numeracy CAAs (Reading, Writing, and Numeracy) will become a compulsory element towards achieving an NCEA certificate. Students will have until the end of their high schooling to achieve these three prerequisites.


