He opined that by the middle of this century the world's population will be about 8 billion. He predicted that the world's population would grow to about 9.5 billion by the end of the century. Population growth in developing countries has not yet been well controlled. That is why the population of the world doubled in the last thirty years.

60% of the total population of the world lives in two countries, mainly China and India. Increasing population affects the economic development of the country. All nations in Asia continue to have higher population growth rates than European nations.

That is why the problems like food shortage, unemployment, crime, high proportion of people below the poverty line, low per capita income are seen in these nations. Population growth can be controlled by three factors namely control of fertility, low mortality and prevention of migration. Rapid population growth can lead to poverty, environmental degradation, resource depletion and social inequality.

He further said that only if the campaign for social, cultural, economic and political upliftment of women is developed, the population will be controlled and the economic level will be raised. For this, high-level corporate leadership should be established for gender equality.

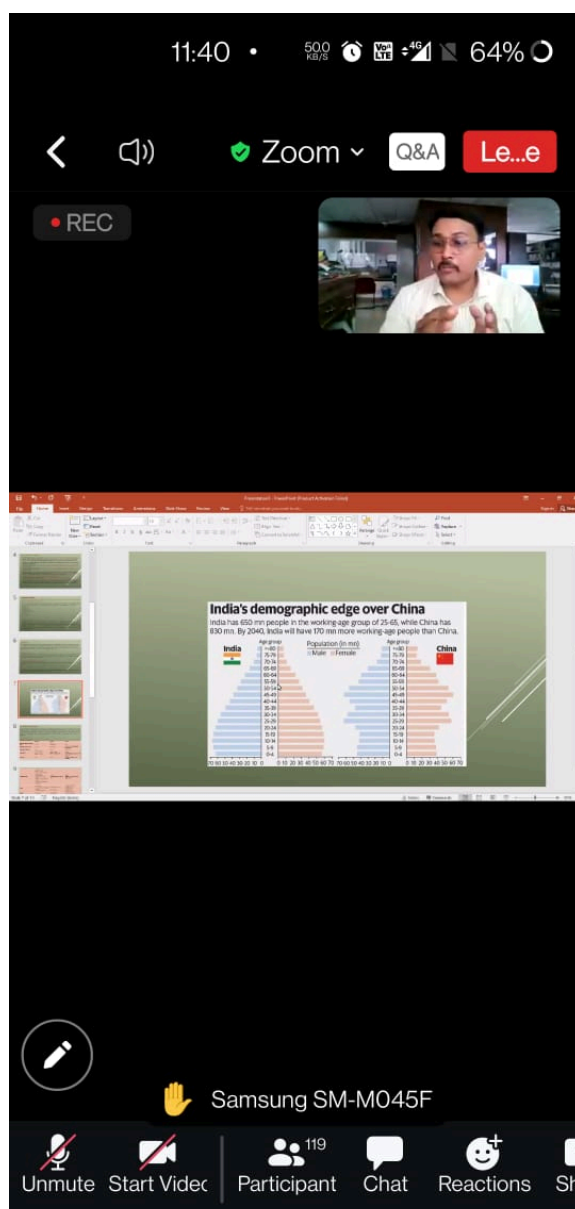
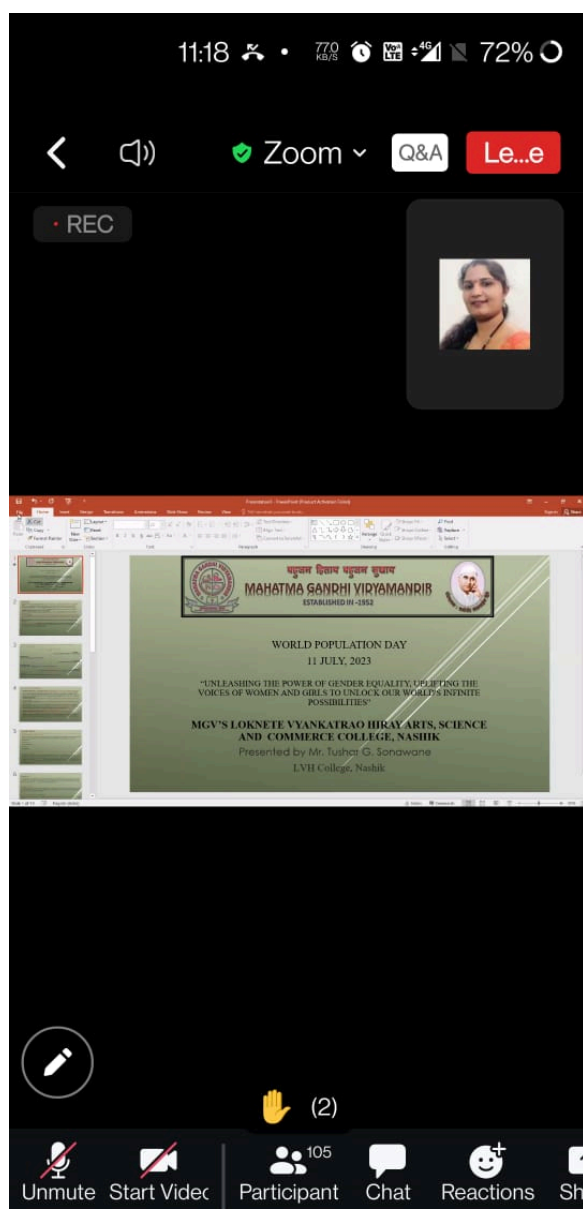

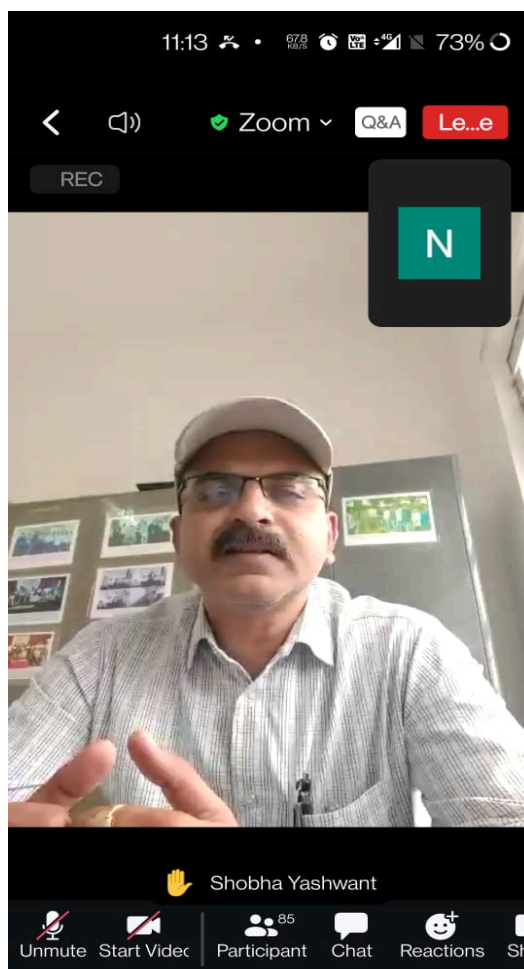
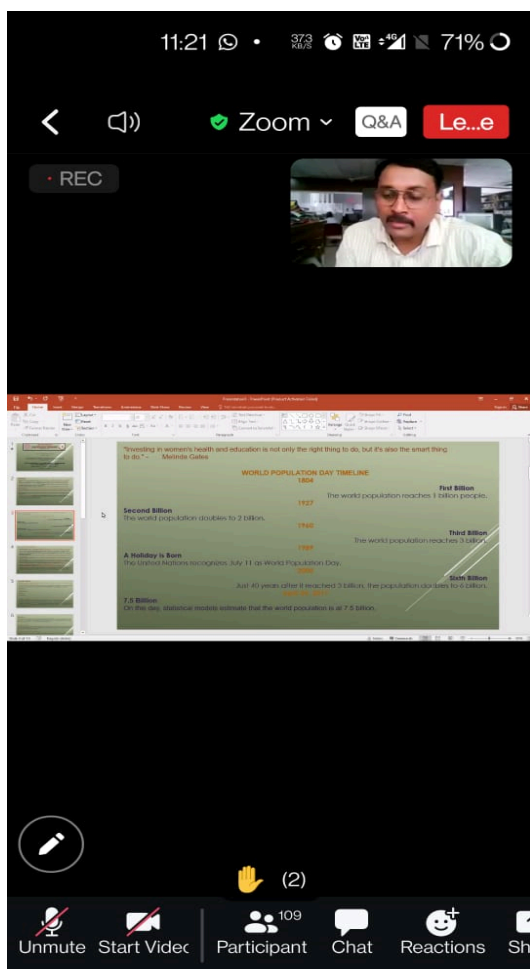
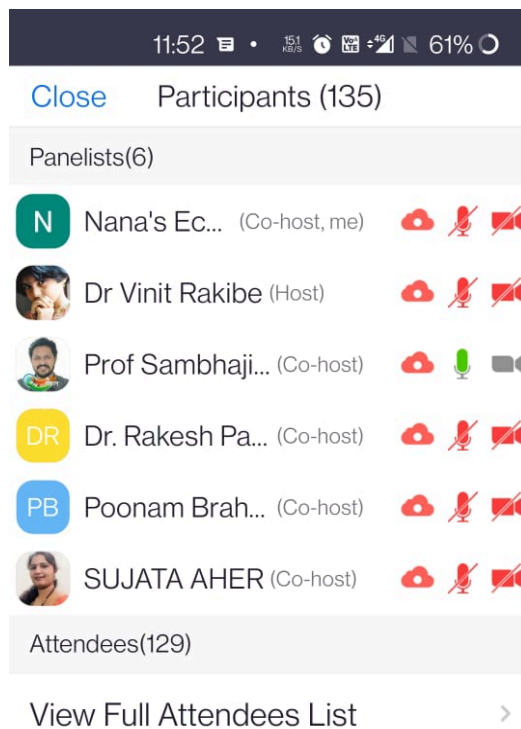
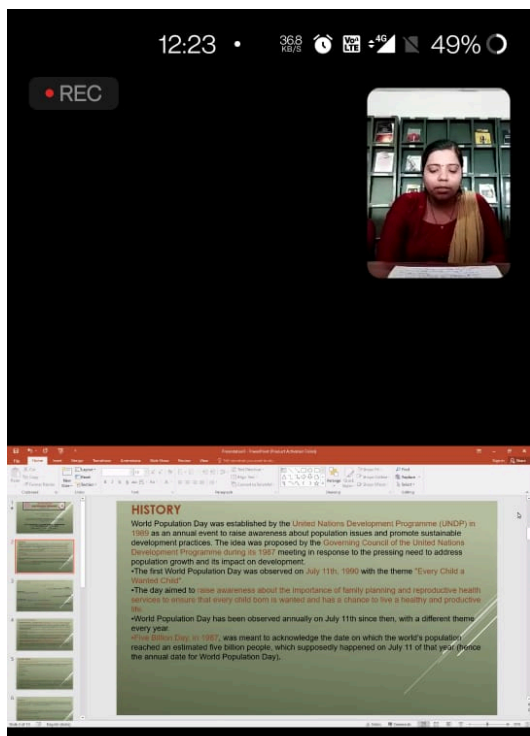
The day also aims to raise awareness about family planning and reproductive health care to ensure that every child born wants and has the opportunity to live a healthy and productive life. He also clarified this time.

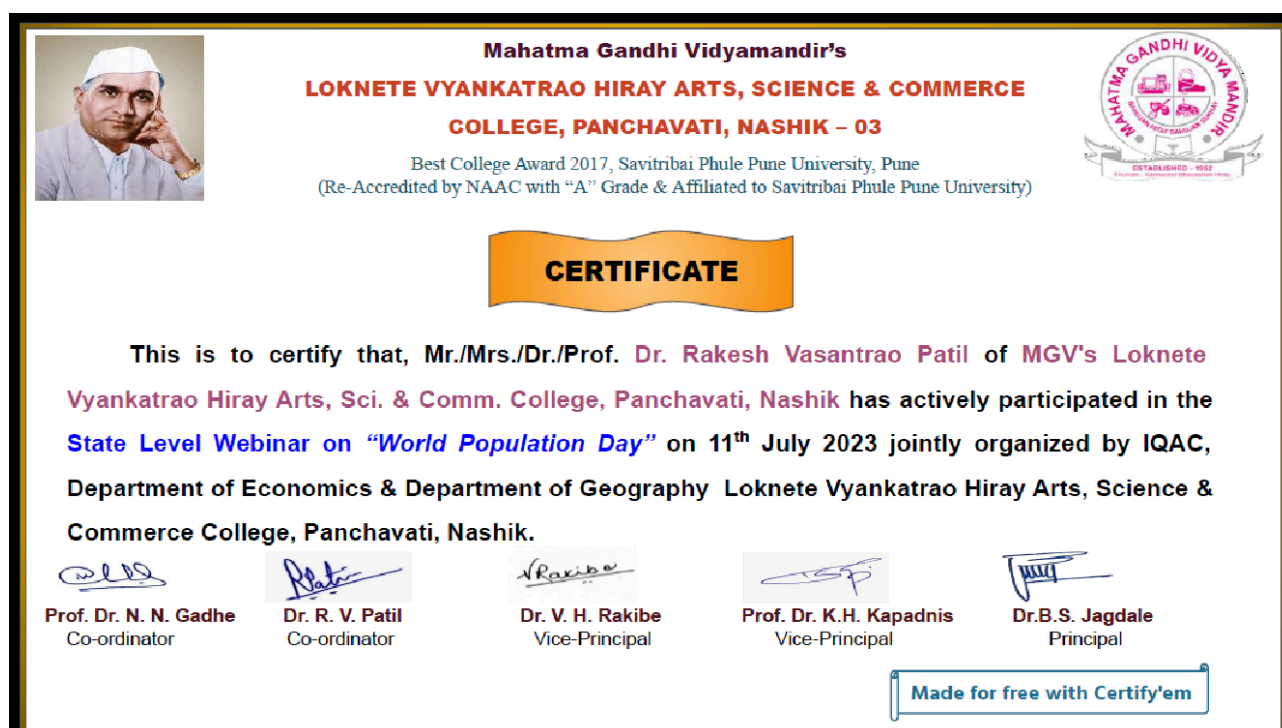
