- Students can sign up for clubs at either school. However, parents/guardians are responsible for transportation.

REGISTRATION DETAILS

- Registration will be through the [Edgemont Elementary PTA](#) site. Please refer to emails sent about pre-registering on this platform and be on the lookout for emails with further registration details and links. Please note that all choices will be held in your cart for 15 minutes to ensure you have enough time to checkout.

- Some clubs fill up very quickly. Please have this information handy when registering:

- If minimum enrollment is not met for a club, you will be notified about cancellation. You will be refunded the club's fee and given the chance to enroll in a different club.
- Any club switch or cancellation requested during the registration period will incur a \$10 fee per club, deducted from your refund to cover non-refundable credit card processing fees.
- If the PTA cancels a club due to low enrollment, you will receive a full refund with no fees. Additionally, no credit card processing fees will be charged if you choose to transfer to another club due to a PTA-initiated cancellation.
- Please note that any changes in registration information entered will incur a \$50 fee after registration closes. Thus, please check your information carefully when registering and inform us of any errors ASAP before we close registration on September 18th.

- Per vendor policy, we are unable to process refunds or club switches after registration closes on September 18th unless a club is canceled.
