The ESE Teacher will develop and implement engaging lessons aligned with state standards and individualized education program (IEP) goals. This position requires a strong commitment to student success, collaboration with colleagues, and the ability to create a structured and supportive learning environment.

Qualifications:

- Bachelor's degree in education or a related field.
- Florida Teacher Certification in Exceptional Student Education (ESE) and Elementary Education.
- Experience working with students with autism or exceptionalities is preferred.
- Knowledge of IEP development & implementation & progress monitoring, applied behavior analysis (ABA), discrete trial training (DTT), social skills training, visual supports, structured teaching, functional communication training, sensory integration techniques, self-management strategies, positive behavior interventions and supports, and task analysis is preferred.
- Strong classroom management skills and the ability to implement positive behavior strategies.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Provide direct instruction in state standards for all assigned subject areas.
- Provide direct instruction on IEP goals as indicated in student IEPs.
- Develop and implement engaging lessons targeting mastery of state standards and IEP goals.
- Supervise and provide direction to ESE Assistants.
- Administer assessments to monitor student progress.
- Monitor student progress towards mastery of state standards and IEP goals.
- Analyze and use student data to inform and adjust instruction.



Participate in Professional Learning Communities (PLCs) to enhance instructional practices.

- Implement effective classroom management strategies to create a positive learning environment.
- Establish and maintain classroom routines and procedures to support student learning.
- Utilize visuals throughout the classroom in all activities and tasks.
- Ensure the use of student-specific communication devices at all times and across all settings.
- Safeguard the health and safety of students at all times.
- Follow current safety procedures pertinent to specific subjects and activities (e.g., science labs, P.E., career and technical education).
- Report health and safety hazards as required.
- Perform other duties as assigned by the school administrator.
