CODE OF CONDUCT

The RL Rams Basketball Club is a non-profit organization formed for the purpose of providing a program that offers our youth an opportunity to develop their skills in basketball. It is also the intent of RL Rams Basketball Club that all participants, including players, parents, coaching staff, referees and spectators, promote the game in a most positive manner.

Players, parents, coaches, referees, and league members all share the responsibility of displaying proper behavior at all times. This is your program, developed to benefit young people. Adult leaders are role models for the players.

<u>PLAYER CONDUCT</u>: Non-sportsmanlike conduct, including disrespect for or harassment of the opposing team's players, coaches, or game referees, such as refusing to shake hands with the other players, etc. will not be tolerated. Players will refrain at all times from arguing with the referees.

<u>COACH CONDUCT</u>: RL Rams basketball coaches will be responsible for the conduct of themselves, their players and their players' parents. Absolutely no abusive language will be tolerated towards players, opposing coaches or game referees.

<u>SPECTATOR CONDUCT</u>: Proper conduct is required of parents and spectators at all times. No swearing or harassment of game referees will be permitted. Spectators shall at no time use degrading comments toward opposing coaches, players, other spectators or game referees.

The RL Rams Basketball Club encourages and demands excellent sportsmanship and respect for all participants. This policy will be enforced.

SATURDAY GAMES ONLY RL RAMS BASKETBALL CLUB

The RL Rams Basketball Club has been a part of the Northeast Wisconsin Boys Basketball League for over 8 years. Games are played on Saturdays only and travelling is expected in this league. Every school in the league is required to host two home events; therefore RL will host home events during January & February. However, the remaining six weeks of boys league you'll be travelling to various northeastern school districts (see school teams below).

Mission Statement:

NWBBL is an organization established to support organized youth basketball. The league promotes sportsmanship through competitive play, while keeping in mind that the end result is not what is important.

Season:

NWBBL has two seasons. The first season plays November-December and the second season plays January-February. RL Coaches/teams select which Saturday dates they want to participate. Teams play two games per every Saturday they are scheduled to play. Practice begins by Nov. 1st.

School Teams:

Schools currently in the program are: Oostburg, Howards Grove, Kiel, Sheboygan North, Sheboygan South, Cedar Grove, Manitowoc, Valders, Plymouth, Appleton, Denmark, Oconto, Mishicot, St. Francis of Assisi, Sheboygan Falls, New Holstein, Mishicot, Luxemburg-Casco, Ashwaubenon Notre Dame, Roncali, St. Cloud, Green Bay Preble, Two Rivers and Random Lake.

Game Rules:

NWBBL follows standard WIAA rules. Games consist of two 20-minute halves with a continuous clock except for time outs and the last one-minute of each half.

Defenses:

3rd / 4th grade – no pressing – man-to-man only.

5th / 6th grade – press last 2 minutes of each half – first half of season is man-to-man only, second half of season can be any defense.

7th / 8th grade – pressing all game – any defense allowed.

All grades – no pressing by leading team if more than 20 point lead.

Grades 3-8:

NWBBL covers grades 3 – 8. (YMCA offers a program for 2nd grade.)

Please note grades 7 & 8 begin playing RL school ball and this league is in addition to school ball.

Fees:

Registration for grades 3 - 8: \$50 for the 2020-2021 season.

Uniform: \$50 for a uniform (jersey & shorts). A new uniform is required for all **NEW** players. Returning players DO NOT need to order new uniforms unless they want/need to. League requires reversible team jersey and matching shorts. **For grades 7 and 8**, school uniforms will be used for weekend play once the school season has started.

Note: Absolutely no registration refund due to prepayment for league play.

Admission:

It is regulated and required that every school hosting their scheduled Saturday will charge an admission fee, \$2 per adult, \$1 for grandparents and children 5-17. Under 5 is free.
