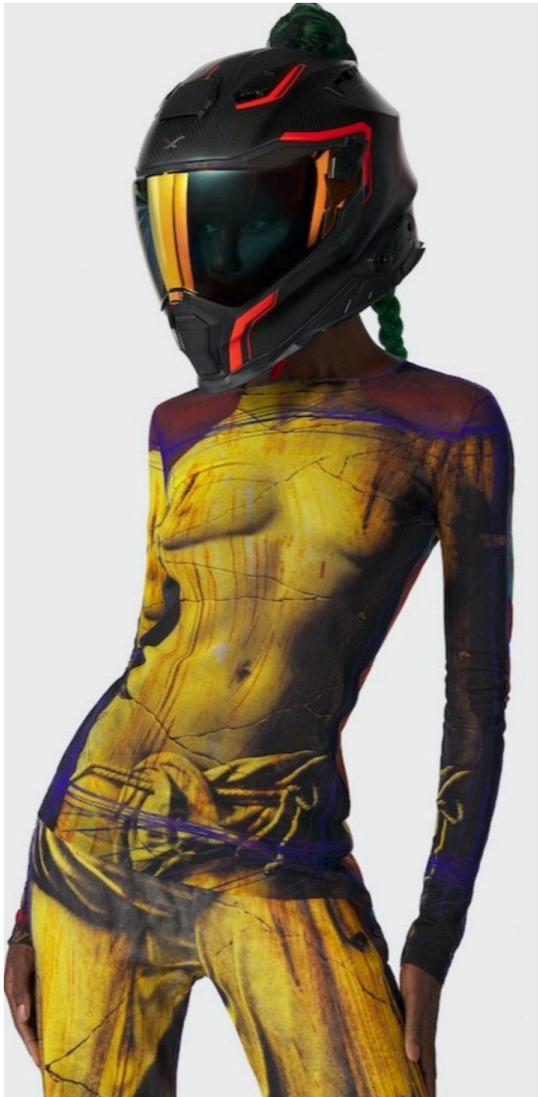


Jean Paul Gaultier BURN Collection, Merging Renaissance Art With Contemporary Clothing Designs



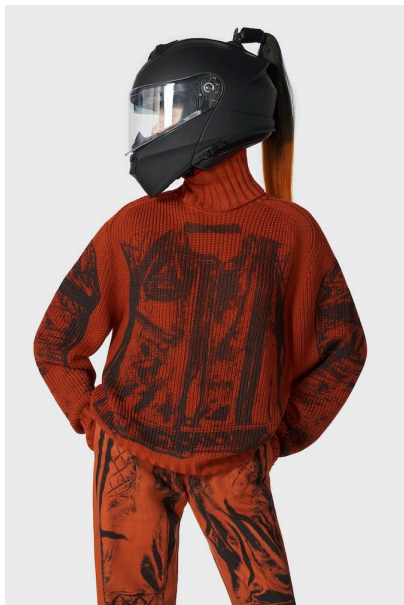

In a partnership with Dover Street Market, [Jean Paul Gaultier](#) has released a new range of clothing called "BURN". The BURN collection is a culmination of Jean Paul Gaultier's research into his luxurious archives, including his spring/summer 1999 and fall/winter 2001 collections.

Clothing with printed statues, leather corsets, and other accessories are examples of the mashup of Renaissance art and biker fashion aesthetics exemplified by the BURN collection.

The clothing line is particularly apparent in the collection's advertising campaign, which features stunt performer Bike Samaca. She casually does dangerous stunts on her bike while modeling the collection.

The rustic yet fashionable line also includes ribbed sweaters, leather jackets with corsets, matching sets, and many other garments with bike graphics or motifs. Black sweatshirts and matching pants with race car graphics and a checkerboard pattern.

The French label incorporates works of art into its collections as well. The cracked torsos of headless sculptures are printed on dresses, long-sleeved blouses, and casual pants. The clothing seen on the statues is constructed of a flexible material that is reminiscent of the sheer mesh tops for which Jean Paul Gaultier is known.



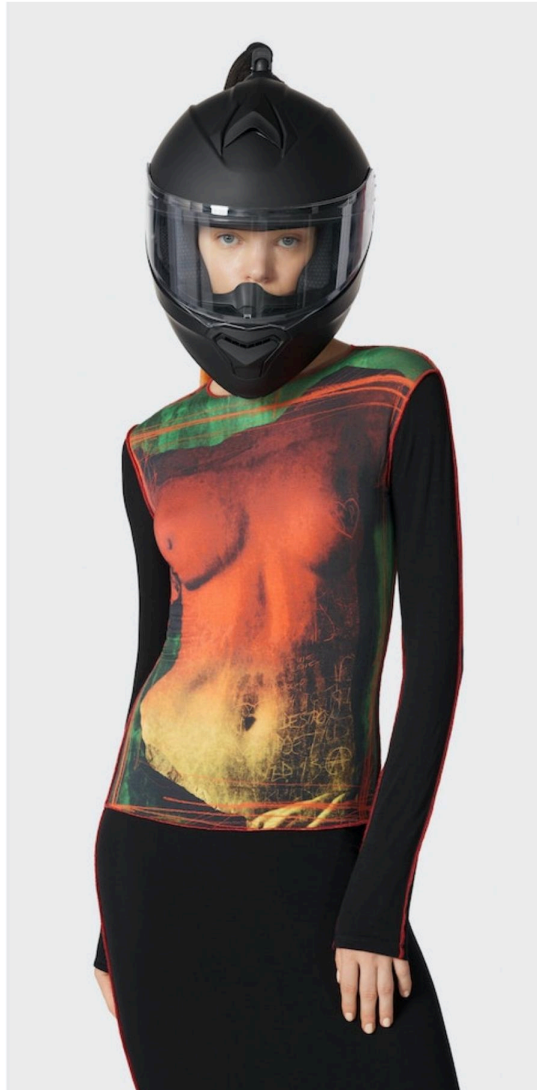

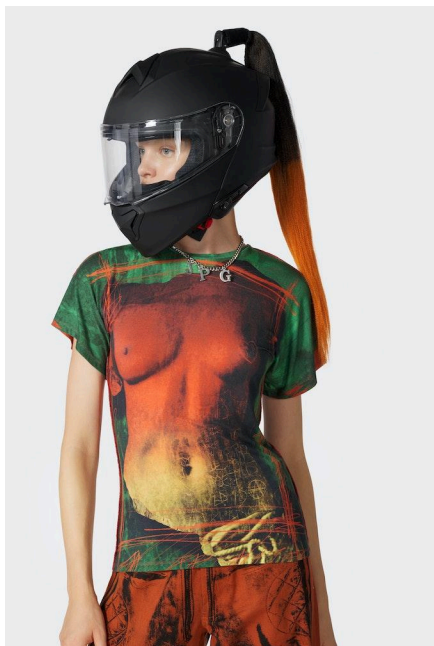

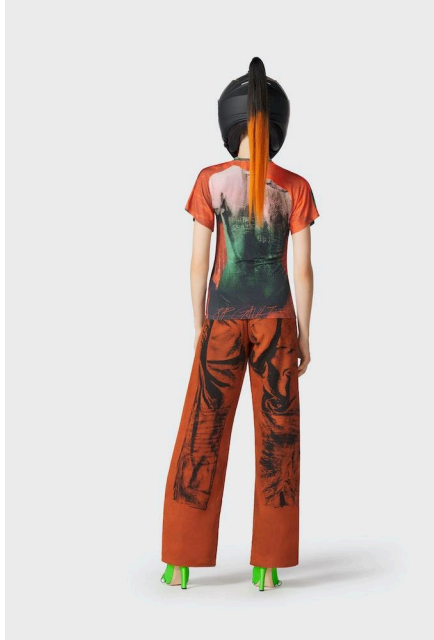

The Statue Print T-Shirt

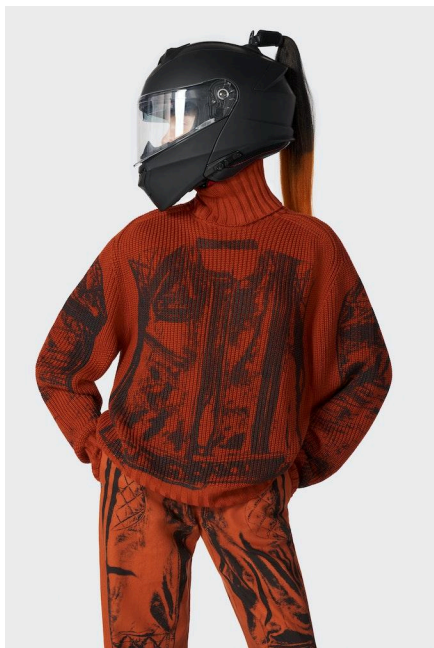

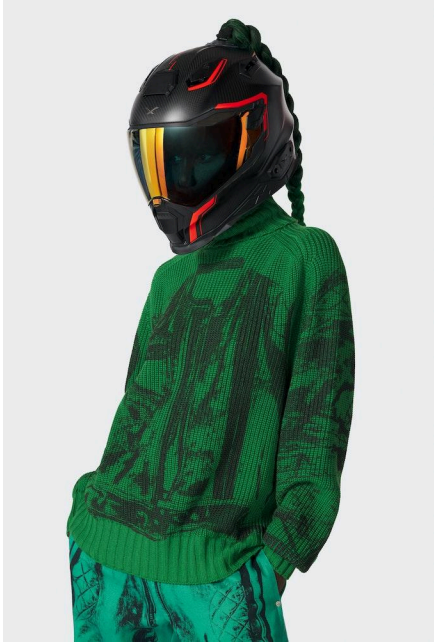


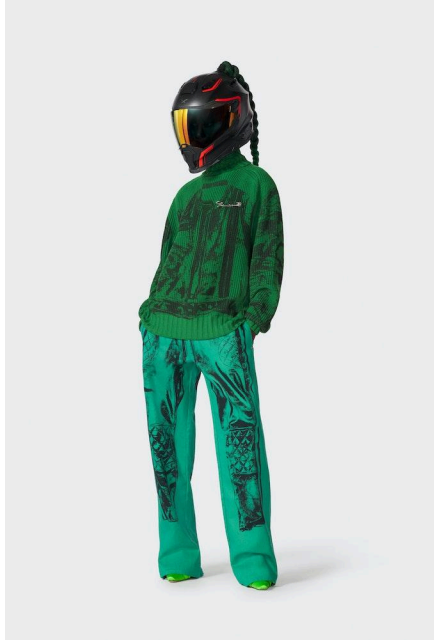
[The Brick-Red Biker Sweater](#)

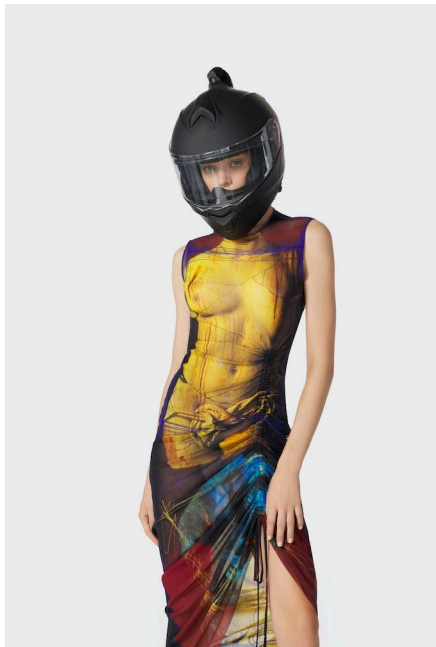




The Statue Draped Dress
