## **EXAMS**

Our first semester exams are scheduled from January 25-31, 2024 for grades 10-12 classes. Our Grade 9 students do not have exams, but each day they can attend school in the morning to finish up work in each of their classes.

Please note that February 1 is a Credit Intervention Day. Students (grades 9-12) may be invited to meet with teachers by appointment only either in-person or by Google Meet.

February 2 is a PD Day. Our second semester begins on February 5. Students can see their class schedules for second semester by logging into their mySPX account (schedules will be updated throughout the month, and students are asked to check their schedules closer to the beginning of second semester.

For students who have an exam for an e-learning course, information will be provided to them directly from their e-learning teacher. The e-learning teacher will be making arrangements for the exams for these courses.



## **CATCH-UP IMMUNIZATION CLINIC**

Once again this year, Ottawa Public Health will be running a catch-up immunization clinic for our students who wish to take part and who need a vaccine to complete their immunization record. This will be held on Thursday February 22 during the school day. It will include immunizations for:

- Meningococcal vaccine (Men-C-ACYW-135)
- Hepatitis B (HB)
- Human Papillomavirus (HPV-9)
- Tetanus, Diphtheria and Pertussis (Tdap)

Ottawa Public Health will be providing additional information including consent forms and information sheets about each vaccine.

In the meantime, please click <u>HERE</u> to view the information about how to check your child's vaccination record and how to update it if necessary. It is important that immunization records be kept up to date with Ottawa Public Health. Information about how to contact OPH is also included.
