

##Resolution In Support Of Rejoining The World Health Organization

###A Resolution affirming the Assembly's support of an American re-entry into the World Health Organization.

WHEREAS the World Health Organization, despite its flaws, has [^{**}necessary duties and functions^{**}](<https://time.com/5836602/world-health-organization-coronavirus/>),

WHEREAS if the United States of America remains out of the World Health Organization, the flaws of the organization can remain unremedied and become greater,

WHEREAS the United States of America should not abandon essential international institutions to foreign, hostile domination,

WHEREAS the ability of the Atlantic Commonwealth to adequately respond to international health crises such as a future pandemic is hindered by the American absence from the World Health Organization,

^{**}§ I. Short Title^{**}

^{**}1.^{**} This resolution may be referred to as the “Resolution In Support Of Rejoining The World Health Organization.”

^{**}§ II. Resolution^{**}

^{**}1.^{**} The Assembly resolves that, in order to ensure that the Commonwealth is in a favorable position to respond to future international health crises and pandemics, it is in favor of the United States of America rejoining the World Health Organization posthaste.

^{**}2.^{**} The Assembly formally encourages the federal government of the United States of America to begin the re-entry process to the World Health Organization.

^{**}3.^{**} The Assembly resolves that it disapproves of a policy of abandoning essential international institutions, no matter how flawed, to foreign domination, as it is likely to hurt the citizens of the Commonwealth in the future.
