

Perpetual AWARD NOTES

Perpetual awards will be awarded once a year and presented at the end of season presentation. The Junior Activities Committee (Nippers Committee) will determine the recipients of these awards.

The nipper awards are grouped into Improvement Awards and Competitor Awards.

Improvement awards will be awarded based on feedback from AM's and coaches. Objective data will also be used such as carnival results and point score results. The Nippers committee makes the final decision on the recipient in a vote.

Competitor awards will be awarded on objective results from the year from point score and carnivals. The U14 competitors will be considered first in awarding the senior awards as it is recognised this is their last year of competition in nippers. The Nippers committee makes the final decision on the recipient in a vote.

BEC WISEMAN AWARD: VOLUNTEER OF THE YEAR

Becky was one of those people who you could rely on to help out, whether it was at the school or the surf club. Happy to lend a hand in any way that she could, without having an 'official' position, she was a person who just willingly chipped in with everything. This award in her memory is for those who always put their hands up to do the endless tasks that keep Nippers moving along without ever seeking recognition. IMPROVEMENT AWARDS

CLARKE FAMILY TROPHY: MOST IMPROVED FEMALE BOARD PADDLER



The Clarke family have made an outstanding contribution to ABSLSC over the last three decades. All three Clarke children were exceptional board paddlers throughout the 90s, and were all members of highly successful board relay teams. They are passionate club members both on and off the sand, and their club values have been continued by Garry's leadership of both the Junior and Senior Clubs. 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CHRIS PARKER TROPHY: MOST IMPROVED MALE BOARD PADDLER

Dedicated to training, Chris medalled in the board, swim and ironman events at Branch, State and Inter Branch levels. He was named Water Captain of the NSW Interstate team in his final year as a Nipper. Now as Age Manager of the U13's, he is passing on his skills and knowledge to the next generation of champions.

ANNIE STALLEY TROPHY: MOST IMPROVED FEMALE BEACH COMPETITOR

Annie was a well-respected and successful beach competitor for Avoca Beach SLSC. She won gold in the sprint at both branch and state level and was a member of the Central Coast Branch and NSW State teams.

MARK WALTERS AWARD: MOST IMPROVED MALE BEACH COMPETITOR

Mark Walters was one of our club's most successful beach competitors winning numerous Branch, State, Australian and World Championships in the flags and sprint events – with multiple successes while competing both as a Nipper and Open competitor through the 70's and 80's. COMPETITOR AWARDS

MARK SAINSBURY SURFER OF THE YEAR

This Award is being presented by Greg Thompson on behalf of the family. Dedicated to the memory of local surfer Mark 'Sanga' Sainsbury. Sanga won the World Amateur title in 1986 and competed on the ASP World Tour. Sanga passed away surfing his local break at Avoca Beach in 1992. He was known for looking at waves in a totally new way.

Surf Life Saving only recently introduced surfing as an event and this Award is aligned to the 2022 NSW Board Riding Championships.

JELFS FAMILY TROPHY: BEACH COMPETITOR OF THE YEAR

This award acknowledges the contribution the Jelfs family made to ABSLSC as longstanding members of our Nippers committee, strong beach competitors, avid club fundraisers and a commitment to their Community.

SHARON BRIETY TROPHY: FEMALE JUNIOR COMPETITOR OF THE YEAR

Sharon Brierty, known to us all as Shaz, has been a member of Avoca beach Nippers since 1971. From 1971-1973 Shaz held her own competing in the boys-only Nippers competition, when women were not allowed to be a part of the surf lifesaving. Her determination, along with the support of some passionate local mums led the way to Avoca Beach developing a Nipperette

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program in 1974. Shaz remains a fierce and talented competitor, a woman of the ocean but at all times has put the club and her teammates first. She is a passionate Avoca Beach competitor who truly embodies the Avoca Beach spirit and we are privileged to call her a Life Member of our club.

DANIEL SHADE TROPHY: MALE JUNIOR COMPETITOR OF THE YEAR

Dan was our most successful Nipper throughout the 1990s, placing at every Branch and State championships throughout his Nipper career. Shadey was a member of the Central Coast Branch team from 1994-1997 and represented NSW at the Inter-State Championships in 1997. Not only was he hugely successful in the water, he always displayed a high level of sportsmanship and put his club and team mates before individual glory. He went on to have a successful career in our senior ranks.

MICHELE DORRELL TROPHY: FEMALE SENIOR COMPETITOR OF THE YEAR

Michele was a member of ABSLSC until 1983 when she tragically lost her life at 17 years of age. Michele was a talented surf competitor, specialising in the belt swim for our successful R&R teams, never losing a point. We are honoured to have both her parents Bobby and Jan as Life Member of our club and long standing member of our Ladies Auxiliary. Michele was a passionate member of our club and community and will be forever remembered as a true Avoca competitor.

HOWARD JONES MEMORIAL TROPHY: MALE SENIOR COMPETITOR OF THE YEAR

In memory of Howard who was a member of Nippers since 1978 until the tragic loss of his life at 24 years. Howard was Age Champion for our surf club every single season and won numerous



Branch and State nipper medals. As a fearless big wave surfer, Howard was the all-round waterman always with a smile on his face. He embodies the true spirit of an Avoca Competitor.
