



OFF-SITE CAREER CENTERS

SCA students who wish to attend off-site career centers for non-SCA programs will still be classified as **full-time Summit Christian Academy students**. Due to the nature of our partnership with off-site career centers, credit for non-SCA programs is transcribed as SCA credit that goes towards the 29 credits for the SCA diploma.

The expectations for SCA students attending an off-site partnering career center -

- a) SCA students should select the career center's AM/morning program as that aligns much better with the schedule at SCA.*
- b) SCA students are expected to come back for periods 4-8 with period 4 being a Life Prep. This allows travel time back to SCA and prompt sign-in at the front desk of the secondary building. The Life Prep **is required** during the fourth period as it negates students having to miss core class lectures and labs.*
- c) SCA students attending off-site partnering career centers **are still expected to attend chapel/small group every Tuesday.***
- d) SCA receives limited spots, those numbers may vary year-to-year, and as such is not able to guarantee placement.*

*If a career center does not have an AM/morning program available, any PM/afternoon programs will have to be approved by administration and the SCA schedule may work around it *if possible*.

*Please note - The MIC Program at Summit Technology Academy is currently not an option for SCA **seniors** as this requires them to be at an off campus internship Tuesday through Thursday, as well as taking college classes off campus Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays.
