We will have a homeroom on the first day of school (student schedule, locker, and home room assignment is viewable in the Home Access Center). Students will also receive a paper copy of their finalized schedule during homeroom on the first day of school. Students will be provided ample time and assistance during the first days of school to find their homeroom, locker, and classrooms. We do not have a homeroom every day at TMS. Students will report to their first period class daily unless otherwise directed.

Notice about SCHOOL FEES:

Please make sure any PAST school year fees or outstanding balances are paid up to date. School fee balances can be viewed in the Pay Schools System. Each year fee statements are sent home from the District Office. All outstanding (prior years or past due) school fees must be paid and up-to-date to be eligible for participation in field trips such as 6th Grade Camp, 8th Grade Washington DC, or other grade level field trips. If you have extenuating circumstances please reach out to the District Treasurer to discuss possible payment plans.

- Final Forms You MUST complete/update this for the 2025-26 school year on-line BEFORE the first day of school (also includes items such as transportation/bussing requests, free-reduced lunch forms, media release, technology agreement, and handbook agreement).
- Students who are driven to school may be dropped off BEHIND the MS/HS in the morning anytime after 7:15am. Please pull forward towards Door 10 (High School) for AM drop off to help keep the cars moving forward. If every car tries to stop and unload right at the Door 7B crosswalk, traffic will back-up! Students should walk on the sidewalk back towards the Middle School and enter through Door 7B. Door 7B will not be unlocked until 7:15am and will relock at 7:40am. Students will report to the cafeteria and remain there until dismissed. Breakfast is available in the cafeteria.
- Students are assigned a locker to use at school. Locker number and combination can be found on the student schedule and in Home Access Center. Students should NOT use any tape or adhesives in/on their locker (magnets only).
- Students must submit a Free/Reduced Lunch Application to qualify for free/reduced lunch and course fee
 waivers
- Supply Lists are posted on the District Website.
- For the <u>5th graders</u> who will be new to the TMS building: The teacher team will welcome them as they enter the building, help them find their rooms (which are right by the main entrance), and build all the necessary orientation topics and procedures into the first few days of school. Teachers will explain how the lockers will be used, help students find their lockers and practice their combination, and provide time for all students to adapt to their new setting. We know this is a new environment for them and we will be welcoming, understanding, and encouraging to them as they experience their new surroundings.

- Front Drive of School is for BUSSES ONLY before and after school during designated times.
- Car/Driver- Before and After School student drop-off & pick-up is at **Door 7B** (back of school)
 - o Must drop off at Back of School- follow one-way traffic loop by THS in and out of back lot
 - o Morning Drop Off & Afternoon Pickup Procedures Car Riders
 - <u>Drop-off 7:15am-7:40am</u>: Back of school ONLY- pull forward along curb towards HS Door 10 and exit to sidewalk side- do not cross other vehicles
 - Enter TMS Door 7B- will be open at 7:15am- report to Cafeteria- breakfast is available
 - <u>Pick-up 2:25pm-2:35pm</u>: Back of School ONLY- line up starting at HS Door 10 according to directions regarding time and grade level
 - Be cautious regarding students crossing traffic and cars exiting lines
 - 5th & 6th Grade Afternoon Pick Up Procedure
 - 5th & 6th Grade Car Rider EARLY RELEASE PERMISSION SLIP
 - 7th & 8th Graders Car Riders Pick Up Plan

Attendance

- Report absence before school starts- can leave a message (330) 837-7807 or speak to TMS building secretary- students MUST BE CALLED OFF from school before 7:45am if they are ABSENT
- Assignments when absent- students can get assignments through google classroom or teacher websites
- Extended absence- call TMS school office to notify of anticipated dates- maintain contact with teachers regarding assignments- google classroom
- Ohio attendance laws- thresholds are based on the number of hours of school missed
- Max of 2 Tardies to school each 9 weeks- 3rd tardy and beyond would result in school consequences
- Max of 5 Vacation days for the school year. Vacation days may not be approved for students with excessive absences or if there is a major conflict with state testing dates.

- A free/reduced lunch form MUST be completed if you wish to qualify for free/reduced lunch or any school FEE waivers. Use Final Forms to apply or contact the school office for more information.
- TMS is not an open campus- no visitors for lunch or fast food deliveries
- <u>Pay Schools System</u>- students use a code number to pay for lunch (lunch extras) or to pay school feescan add to balance on-line or students can drop off payments at the Main Office in the morning before school (put in an envelope with title of Lunch Money, student name, grade and date).
