

HOW TO MAKE FABRIC SQUARES FOR GIFT WRAPPING

WHAT DO WE NEED:

- Cotton fabric,
- a ruler and a pencil,
- thread,
- sewing pins and
- a sewing machine or needle.

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Measure the size of the squares on the fabric, either by eye or with a ruler. Standard sizes are 30×30 cm, 50×50 cm and 70×70 cm.
- 2. Fold the edges of the square twice about 1 cm from the edge and secure the fabric with pins.
- 3. Using a sewing machine or just by hand, sew the fabric to the inside of the fold and cut the remaining thread. Pay particular attention to the corners of the square where more fabric crosses.
- 4. Iron over the final fabric squares with an iron to make them beautifully smooth and you're ready to wrap presents!
