Diet: Twoscruel are known to primarily feed by digesting prey from the inside out, utilizing their cheese-spores to reproduce from prey they do not intend to fully digest. They are not picky eaters, and will generally speaking eat any people or pokemon smaller than them in size. Despite this, their favorite prey of all is Alcremie, as they do not put up a fight and are incredibly nutrient-dense, however, they are incapable of cultivating spores in Alcremie bodies. Behavior and Personality: Twoscruel are, as the name suggests, incredibly cruel creatures. They have minimal sense of morality, but despite this are incredibly cunning organisms who set up traps composed of scalding spore-laden cheese webs to capture their prey. They are often quite cheerful in the face of brutality as a result of their gruesome feeding methods. They are shockingly easy to tame, however, be warned that they do not view their trainers as "friends" so much as "allies". They will gladly defend you so long as you assist them in kind, but do not deal well with conflicts of interest with their trainer, and if you are too weak, they will take advantage of you rather than obey if you have a quarrel. They will, however, offer a cheese product absent of spores as a gift for trainers who they have developed some semblance of a bond with. Predators: Twoscruel are rarely consumed by anything but bug types, as their bodies are highly infectious to most organisms and bug types are able to eat their flesh with precision to avoid the spores. In spite of this, after freezing the caps, thawing them, then cooking them, they can act as effortless, and thankfully harmless, stuffed mushroom caps for humans, making them another primary predator.

Habitat: Twoscruel primarily inhabit the floors of forest borders, where there is a lot of grass and shade.

Other ecological notes: Twoscruel are incredibly feared by most pokemon. They are occasionally parasitized by small, growing colonies of the solosis line as a starting bacterial substrate. They will never prey on other fungus types, and form close social bonds with them easily.

Notable Alternative Phenotypes: Certain Twoscruel will have yellow staining on the cap where damaged, and both their cheese and caps will be poisonous and taste like bleach. Their cap frills are occasionally long and flowing, or on rare occasions be completely absent.

Uses: Twoscruel can be eaten when prepared correctly, and their tendrils can be used for a makeshift rope, however acquiring any material from Twoscruel in the wild is considered unwise due to their fearsome personalities.

Cultural significance: These pokemon are often portrayed as villains in childrens stories, being explained as terrifying creatures in the forest to be avoided at all costs, or trickster characters bent on mischeviously inconveniencing townsfolk. Twoscruel ownership is considered controversial by some.
