Dear Families –

Yesterday, our distance learning plan was approved by the governor's office and the North Dakota Department of Public Instruction. In that plan, which you can find on our website, it spells out how we will provide learning for our students until the schools in North Dakota reopen.

Some things that you and your children need to be aware of include – the kids **MUST** do work – paper assignments, or through Google Classroom. Teachers will also have video chats with their students and are available to kids from 8:15 to 4:00 each day.

Attendance will be taken when kids check in with their teachers. They can do that through Google Classroom, emailing their teacher, sending a text message, calling their teacher(s) – which ever method works best for them.

Students can submit assignments through Google Classroom, email, taking a picture and sending that, submitting paper assignments – these can be returned to the people who are delivering lunches.

Students can still get a Chrome book if they need or want one, just contact the school.

In order to make certain that our kids and families are safe, teachers and paras will attempt to contact students twice, if they are unable to do so, administration will then attempt to contact the student and/or family. If they are unable to make contact, we will request a welfare check for the family by law enforcement.

If anyone in your household becomes sick, please notify the school. We need to keep our food delivery staff safe.

Our greatest wish is that everyone remains healthy and well. Stay safe and practice social distancing.
