

To volunteer as a screener, please register for a class using the instructions below:

- 2. Once logged in, search for the required class using keywords like "VISION," "HEARING," or "SPINAL."
- 3. Select either the Certification or Recertification class based on your current status. Certification is valid through the calendar year in which it expires.
- 4. Sign up genius (CLICK HERE)
