Escuchemos:

- Listen to each conversation. Then, choose the answer that best describes what each one is about. (1 pt each; 5 total)

Leamos:

- Read Elena and Anita's conversation and write A for cierto or B for falso. (1 pt each; 5 total)

Vocabulario:

- Rebeca is telling a cousin about what her new neighbors do. Read each description. Then write the name of the profession that corresponds to the description to complete the statement that follows. (1 pt each; 5 total) The information will be in Spanish about these people. I gave you practice pages that should help give you an idea. For example, "Jorge cuida a los enfermos." What would you write? BE CAREFUL!!!! Look at the who the sentence is describing! Watch for singular/plural and feminine/masculine. Don't forget to study the professions that are the same word for both genders as well as the ones that change for feminine and masculine. What are some that for the feminine, you cannot simply change it to "a?"
- Match each phrase to the appropriate situation in which it would be used. (1 pt each; 5 total) The pages that I gave you with practice with the blue and cream boxes could help with this part. If you don't still have your copies, you may go on the website under Spanish IIA and print them off.
- Marcos writes his grandmother to tell her about his new neighborhood. Use the vocabulary words to complete the sentences. (1 pt each 5 total) So you do have a word bank here; however, be careful and use them correctly.
- Complete the Spanish phrases that would be used in the following situations. (2 pts each; 10 total) This could be a challenging section if you did not study your vocab and the phrases. Again, I cannot stress enough how important it is to know the blue and cream boxes. So I would again stress that you should study the practice sheets that I gave you as well as what is in the book.

Gramática:

- Alberto's younger twin sisters are describing their "dream" school to him. Complete the sentences with the correct indirect object pronoun. (1 pt each; 5 total) This should be a review; however, some of you are still struggling with this. Ask yourself, what are the indirect objects? How do I find them?
- Tina is telling Roberto what different people in her neighborhood do. Complete each sentence with the correct form of a verb from the box and correct indirect object pronoun. (2 pts each; 10 total) You do have a verb box to choose from for the correct verb; however you may or may not need to conjugate it. Study your formulas again. Where do the pronouns go if there is a formula or is not? You can do this!
- Rolando just moved to a new neighborhood and is trying to get to know the place and the people. Complete the following conversation he has with Ricardo, a new friend, with the correct forms of "saber" or "conocer." (2 pts each; 10 total) Be careful! We have gone over this but this is also in conversation format. Read everything carefully!
- People on your block come from all over the world. Use the verb SER and the information given to tell what nationality they are and what their professions are. (2 pts each; 10 total) Did you look in the book and study the professions information and notes? Watch for agreement both singular and plural, masculine and feminine.
- Ser vs Estar vs Tener! Write the correct form of the verb on the line (2 pts each; 32 total) Yes, this a huge part of the quiz; however, using these verbs correctly is so critical for Spanish. If it's tener, did you study the "tener phrases/idioms?" They are listed in the book but ALSO study what I gave you as I wrote this section. Also, if it's a form of "tener" it could also be part of a tener formula. For example, "Jorge -- que estudiar para su prueba." What would go on the line? Be sure to study what we have gone over in class. You had a lot of practice with these verbs.
