About the Organization:

Skimo Northwest is a non-profit organization dedicated to growing the sport of skimo racing. We achieve this through organizing and hosting high-quality skimo races, advocating for uphill access and responsible recreation at local ski resorts, and developing youth programs to introduce the next generation to the sport.

Position Summary:

The Local Race Director is responsible for the planning, execution, and success of a race event in collaboration with the ski resort. This role requires strong organizational, communication, and problem-solving skills, as well as a passion for the sport of skimo racing.

Key Responsibilities:

Strategic Planning:

- Develop the race course in collaboration with ski resort personnel, ensuring safety and an exciting athlete experience.
- Coordinate with ski patrol, marketing, and other resort staff on race day logistics.
- Identify necessary equipment and supplies

Race Coordination:

- Oversee the coordination and planning of all aspects of the races, including course design, permits, safety protocols, and logistics.
- Develop and disseminate race information (course maps, schedule).
- Collaborate with key stakeholders, such as local ski shops, sponsors, vendors, and authorities, to ensure successful race execution.
- Recruit volunteers for race day operations

Race Operations

- Lead course marking team to ensure adequate safety for racers, volunteers, and resort public guests.
- Choreograph all moving parts, staff members, and liaison with ski resort staff.
- Anticipate and manage unforeseen circumstances and adapt quickly to ensure a smooth execution.

Risk Management:

- Identify and mitigate potential risks associated with the race series, including safety hazards, weather-related issues, and unforeseen circumstances.
- Develop and implement emergency response plans.

Post-Race Analysis:

- Conduct a thorough evaluation of each race, gathering feedback from participants, volunteers, and stakeholders.
- Identify areas for improvement and implement necessary changes for future events.

Task Breakdown:

Pre-Race Planning

- Work with Head RD to set seasonal event calendar and ensure no overlapping events.
- o Take lead on planning communications with ski resort Patrol/Events staff.
- Design Race Course and map.
- Supply information for Race Operations Plan.
- Identify racer categories/awards.
- o Identify Volunteer Needs and send to Head RD.
- Review race webpage and send any updates to Head RD. Web permissions can be given to Local RD if desired.
- Submit USA Skimo sanctioning/Cup application if desired.
- Submit requests for schwag/awards to Head RD.
- Develop partnerships with local organizations and brands that are in line with overall Skimo Northwest branding and our Partnership Opportunities.
- o Develop intimate race partnership with selected local uphill oriented Ski Shop.
- Write "Message from the Race Director" piece for newsletter.
- Help source local volunteers and direct them towards online signup.
- Write updates to racers, including Racer Pre-Race email the week prior to event.
- Lead virtual Staff Meeting (if needed).

Event Operations

- Submit request to Head RD on what race supplies are needed.
- Lead Course Setup.
- o Run Gatekeeper Meeting and Racer Meeting.
- Choreograph all event day operations.
- Ensure all course materials are collected.
