IV. Strategic Discussion--What is our niche? Why do we exist?

Kirk questions – relevancy of SDMB. How are we different from other groups in the Tucson area?

Compared to Old Pueblo which schedules social rides, or Our MTB Rides, Cranksters, Addicts, etc.

Are we filling a Tucson niche?

Beware the activity trap (real property owned by SDMB).

Mike – advocacy, create and maintain opportunities.

SDMB should be available to work with local trail managers

TORCA = Lemmon, SDMB = lower elevations

Social events/rides is not our mission (e.g. ebikes, trail etiquette).

Leif – echo Mike, also SDMB is a problem solver (e.g. Big Wash).

Dave – OurMTB is a facebook ride group, not doing more.

SDMB continues to work even without exposure events.

Britt - Trail build, advocacy.

Cliff – advocacy, promotion, stewardship. Cliff struggled to understand SDMB role at the beginning.

All other group aspects incorporated,

Need more promotion.

Trail etiquette.

Nat – advocacy vs social

MBAA group is example of identity (credential)

Tucson Mtn Estates – SDMB credential, credibility

Perhaps SDMB credibility is too centralized

SDMB creates connection

Evan – credibility to show up and solve problems

CV (?) allows speed to show up and solve problems

Kirk - the Montana (MT) Board is more cohesive than SDMB

They have >2,500 members

Q: Are they active?

A: it gives a level of credibility; can be mobilized

MT Dirt hero is a mechanism for \$ revenue rather than charging a yearly dues

SDMB existence / mission is in agreement

SDMB Board could be more cohesive. Need to work on this

SDMB history (Evan) – monthly board meetings

A Strategy has been that committees feed the board

Deletion of social rides was experimental

Cliff idea – show a list of SDMB accomplishments at TH tables

Kirk – SLACK – information channels (targeted, focused), more efficient than google groups. We need a more focused method for communication among board members rather than a global email ist.

Consensus was that we definitely have a reason for being and fill an important niche that no one else can fill. We are the only group in the Tucson valley committed to building, maintaining and protecting trails for MTBers. Our focus is advocacy, outreach education, trail development and marketing. We need to keep these ideas front and center.
