

Muse Fund– FAQs

-How are funds distributed?

Funds may be distributed via cash, check, or digital payment. Digital payment is preferable for applicants outside of the Lodi, California area where we are based.

-Where do the funds come from?

Muse Fund is privately funded. All grant money distributed comes from our members and local donors.

-What if my artistic genre isn't listed on the submission guidelines?

Here at Muse Fund, we are devoted to supporting young creatives in all their artistic endeavors! If the genre of art you practice and wish to submit an application under is not listed, email us at themusefund@gmail.com to further clarify your situation.

-What happens if I win a grant competition?

First, second, and third place winners will be emailed shortly after the deadline. From there, they will receive their cash prize within 1-2 weeks of being contacted. Winners may be asked for additional information on their submission materials and may be interviewed via Zoom for our social media platforms. Honorable mentions may be posted as well.

-What are the requirements for participating in a grant competition?

To submit your creative work to Muse Fund, you must be a highschool student (grades 9-12) attending school in the United States. All materials must be the original work of the applicant. Plagiarizing artwork will result in disqualification.
