SUBJECT: 22-23 CIC 30: Course reviewed and approved by the Writing Skills Subcommittee (WSS) on 2/13/23 requiring Senate approval

PURPOSE: Action by the Academic Senate

ACTION REQUESTED: That the Academic Senate approve the summary list of courses approved by WSS as writing intensive (WI) courses that fulfill the Graduation Writing Requirement (GWAR)

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

In AY 2021-2022, the Senate recommended and the President approved a new GWAR policy (see [21-22 CIC 50](#)), which guides the implementation of a course-based, writing intensive (WI) approach to GWAR fulfillment. The first WI courses will be offered in AY 2023-2024. The following courses were reviewed and unanimously approved by the Writing Skills Subcommittee at their 11/28/22 meeting. At the CIC meeting on 1/23/23, CIC members discussed and approved [insert vote count] the courses listed below for WI credit.

Similar to the process used by the General Education, Overlay and Code Subcommittee, CIC will refer the WI documents to Senate with a single general designation code (e.g. 21-22 CIC 47) with each course listed by a subsidiary designation code (e.g. 21-22 CIC 47-1 through 21-22 CIC 47-1).
