



The Alhambra and You

The Order of the Alhambra, Inc. is an International Organization of Catholics which promotes social, fraternal and intellectual associations and through its Caravans, provides a practical means to form enduring fellowship and friendship among its members. This charitable group holds local units throughout the United States and Canada.

When you become a member of the Order of the Alhambra, Inc., you become part of our family. You will join our members in doing things for the church and community. We serve God's Special Friends, the intellectually disabled. The Order of Alhambra Charity Fund, Inc. provides grants for scholarship assistance and facilitates to educate and treat the intellectually disabled.

We offer summer camp grants to the intellectually disabled, who otherwise could not afford it on their own. Through our Alhambra House Project, we provide assistance in establishing group homes for those intellectually disabled and assure their attaining a useful life in society

Consider becoming a member of your local Caravan today. The Order of the Alhambra, Inc., was founded more than a century ago in February, 1904. A small group of Catholic men met in Brooklyn, NY, to form the first Caravan. Alhambra is named after a Moorish palace in Granada, Spain, where the Moors surrendered to Ferdinand and Isabella in 1492. The emblem of the Order depicts the Red Castle, with cross

and a crescent that represents the almost 800 years Moorish occupation of Spain.

We continue preserving and commemorating Catholic historical places, events and persons of importance. Our Historical Memorials program has placed more than 160 bronze plaques across North America that defines the historical significance of the memorialized site. On September 17, 1980, the Order of the Alhambra, Inc., completed their goal of a trip to Rome. There, they were greeted by His Holiness, Pope John Paul II, who graciously accepted his Alhambra fez. He then blessed the fez and thanked its members.

The Order of the Alhambra, Inc., has so much history we would be forever in writing it down. Although our history has been a true blessing; it is now time for us to look to the future.

By becoming a member, you receive personal reward with the intellectually disabled. You will feel their love when you catch them at the finish line of a Special Olympic event or join in games with them at picnics and outings, or when you receive a hug from them on presentation of the gift of a new wheelchair, or taking them to the circus, boat rides, Christmas parties and so much more. Or to see their tears of joy when they just know you are there.
