First, voters choose party affiliation through party declaration with the County Clerk's Office when registering to vote.

Second, Mr. Chamberlain's proposal may be in conflict with the very first paragraph from our Bylaws, Section 1 on Membership which states: "Residents of Davis County, who identify themselves as Republicans and who support Republican Party candidates shall be members of the Davis County Republican Party (DCRP)."

The purpose of this replacement proposal is to recommend that we not focus on membership, which is something that we technically do not even track, but rather to enact sanctions that the party has the authority to enact in order to create a "wall of shame" for Republicans who do not support the caucus-convention system.

SECTION 7.8 ELECTIONS

7.8.7 The only authorized method recognized by the DCRP to qualify for the primary Election is via the Caucus-Convention Stem as contained in the Constitution and Bylaws.
