I. NATURE OF THE ACTION

- 1. The Commonwealth of the Chesapeake brings this action to protect themselves and their residents from the unlawful actions of /u/Murpple. Law enforcement has been investigating the Defendant extensively finding the Defendant potentially involved with the domestic terrorist attack against Assembly Member /u/GoogMastr.
- 2. Accordingly, the Prosecution seeks a warrant of arrest for the defendants.

II. JURISDICTION

3. This court has jurisdiction over this Complaint pursuant to Chesapeake Code § 19.2-72 because this case involves a criminal action arising under the laws of the Commonwealth of the Chesapeake.

III. PARTIES

4. Prosecutor, the Commonwealth of the Chesapeake is a sovereign state in the United States of America. The Commonwealth of the Chesapeake brings this action through the Attorney General /u/Alexander-FM. The Attorney General is the chief law officer of the Commonwealth of Chesapeake and is authorized to file a criminal suits directly involving the State's rights and interests or deemed necessary by the general interests to protect public rights and interests.

IV. EVIDENTIARY FINDINGS

- 5. This Warrant is being lawfully executed due to the fact that /u/Murpple committed attempted crimes with the same *modus operandi* in Lincoln; as such, there is strong reason to believe that /u/Murpple may be involved in this crime due to the similar nature.
- 6. Evidence towards this finding are as follow:
 - a. A statement released by Assembly Member /u/GoogMastr
 - b. A statement released by House Representative /u/Ninjiadragon

V. FACTUAL ALLEGATIONS

- 7. The Commonwealth of the Chesapeake hereby charges the Defendant with:
 - a. Attempt to commit capital offense; in violation of § 18.2-25.
 - b. Committing, conspiring and aiding and abetting acts of terrorism; in violation of § 18.2-46.5(a).

- c. Possession, manufacture, distribution, etc. of weapon of terrorism; penalties in violation of § 18.2-46.6(a).
- d. Malicious bodily injury by use of any explosive or fire; in violation of § 18.2-52.
- e. Burning or destroying any other building or structure; in violation of § 18.2-80.
- f. Manufacture, possession, use, etc., of fire bombs or explosive materials or devices; in violation of § 18.2-85.
