*Fixed Tuition In-State Resident Students

Beginning 2016-17, incoming UNC Asheville in-state undergraduate degree-seeking students are eligible for the same tuition rate for eight continuous enrollment semesters through North Carolina's Fixed Tuition Program. Required fees are not included in the tuition rate and may increase annually. Fixed tuition does not apply towards the summer semester. Learn more about North Carolina's Fixed Tuition Program.

Beginning 2021-22, the billing methodology for students enrolled less than full time (12 credit hours) will be billed at an hourly rate. Students eligible for fixed tuition and enrolled in between 1

and 11 credit hours will continue to be billed using the stair-step methodology as demonstrated below.

Health Insurance:

Students who are degree seeking and taking 6 or more in-person credit hours are required to have health insurance to attend a UNC system school. Students with existing health insurance coverage can waive out of the school insurance plan. **\$2,784.80** is the 2024-25 annual cost of insurance offered through Student Blue, underwritten by Blue Cross and Blue Shield of North Carolina (BCBSNC).

^{*}The Health Services fee will be billed separately beginning in the 24/25 school year. It is still considered part of the required fee charges.

Orientation Fee:

There is a one-time orientation fee of \$150 charged to all new freshmen and transfer students. Students who attend orientation but who subsequently do not attend the University are still responsible for payment of the orientation fee.

Returned Check/ACH Fee:

A fee of \$35 is charged for any check or ACH payment (electronic check) returned to the university by the bank for any reason.

Schedule Reinstatement Fee:

A schedule reinstatement fee of \$100 is charged if a student has his or her schedule canceled and wishes to enroll in classes again. The student's original schedule will be subject to class availability.

Late Graduation Application Fee:

Students must submit an online application for graduation by the appropriate deadline, listed below. Students who do not submit the application by the deadline will be required to pay a late application fee of \$100 prior to applying.

- For May graduation, the application is due December 1
- For Summer graduation, the application is due June 1
- For December graduation, the application is due September 1

Diploma Replacement Fee:

A fee of \$20 is charged per diploma replacement request. There is an accompanying form required by the Registrar's office to be completed.
