For commissions

This TOS comes in full force and effect on the 7th of April 2024

I will be updating it if anything changes (and writing down what I changed and when I did it on the last page)

What I will and won't draw:

I will draw:

- > anthros (mainly insects, regular furs and scalies are also an option, however I have less experience drawing those)
- > other species - ask me :3
- > most fetishes (100% will draw vore, pregnancy, watersports, sounding, infestation/parasites, farts, bondage/encasement, feet, tickling, light CBT, oviposition and weight gain - ask for other)
- > comics - priced the same way as regular drawings - comic pages may start at £150/£200 per page
- > reference sheets
- > designs: I can do most insects, insectoids and I can try doing some arachnids - when in doubt, ask me about it or ask for relevant examples

I won't draw:

- > excessive gore / guro (small injuries are fine, just not guts spilling out nstuff)
- > scat
- > mechs, guns
- > overly complex characters

- > weapons
- > underage / child-looking characters in nsfw (aka no lolis, shotas etc.)
- > my characters in commissions - I can make some exceptions for a few of them, however, Row and Ermine are off limits, no matter the theme of the commission
- > complex BDSM gear (pup hoods, lotsa belts, lotsa ropes, bitch suits etc.)

Drawing Tiers and Prices:

1) **sketch** – just a sketch with the only colour being a solid background fill; can be requested to be transparent and/or done with an MS Paint-friendly / pixelated brush

2) **coloured sketch** – a sketch coloured like a flat colour; can be requested to be drawn with an MS Paint-friendly / pixelated brush

4) **flat colour** – lined and coloured drawing with no shading

5) **shaded** – lined and coloured drawing with shading

a) **bust** – may or may not include the character's shoulders; price for single body parts – such as just the character's loins – will be based on the bust's price (there are two busts in the sketch example)

b) **half body** – includes the character's body up to the waist; can either be from head to waist or from feet to waist

c) **thigh-up** – includes all poses that involve cutting of the character before their knees

d) **full body** – well... I mean... the whole character is visible

All prices are in GBP; Each price is for one character - there is no discount for additional characters

List of Fees and Discounts

Fees:

- **Details (£5 - £15)** - if your character has a detailed design or elements which are hard to draw then this fee applies; I'm most used to designs as detailed as Bug Fables sprites
- **Fetishes (£5 - ?)** - it depends on how much of the fetish is in the drawing and how complicated it is to draw. Fees which are pretty stable so far:
 - Vore (oral) - £10
 - Farts (just a fart cloud) - £5
- **Backgrounds (£15 - ?)** - depends on complexity; for coloured sketches the price would start at £15 and for fully shaded drawings at £40; however, if the background is just a sheet or something very simple then it may be around
- **Alts (£5 - ?)** - depends on complexity and the number of alterations I'd have to make to a piece; £5 could be a price for a simple cum alt for a coloured sketch drawing; If you'd like an alt, please say so before payment, in the initial consultation
- **Keeping a commission private (£10 - ?)** - it means that the commission will not be posted, won't be marked in the commission slots, and I won't show it to anyone; it's essentially a flat fee, it may only go up if it's some elaborate piece that will take a lot of time to make (e.g. a 3-page comic);
- **Perspective shots (£10 - ?)** - any shots which involve more extreme views
- **Extra views and objects** - for any close-ups/different views or extra objects that appear in the drawings (example above); simple objects start at £5 for sketches; views are priced like separate drawings
- **Extreme size differences / specific sizes (£5 - ?)** - this usually means I need to make an extra 3d reference to accurately portray the characters' heights
- **Designing (£15-?)** - creating a character design based on description or some visual aids provided by you; this can also include a redesign; This adds an additional step to the process as before I start working on the actual commission I create a pre-ref - a messy, usually coloured, drawing that presents the design - in order to get the idea of what character I'm working with and whether the design looks good to you

Discounts

Repeated customers (5+ commissions*) will receive a **5%** discount for the 6th and each subsequent commission

Aka, if your fully shaded pic costs £100, now it costs £95

One picture = one commission

*YCHs don't count as commissions

General Process

1) **Consultation**: We get in touch through any of my socials and you describe your idea for the drawing – doesn't have to be incredibly specific; you can just say what you want to happen or be implied to happen in the picture and I'll try to figure something out; This is when you send all the character references and describe all the details you want included

2) **Quotation**: I consider the general or specific idea and see if I can do it; If I can then I give you the total price for the drawing – here we can negotiate the details or the tier of the drawing to see what works best for you

3) **Payment**: After agreeing on the price I send you a payment request through Paypal for which I need your Paypal e-mail address; After I receive the funds I mark the commission slot as taken

4) **Concept sketch**: It is a very rough and messy sketch that varies wildly in detail from commission to commission. It is a sketch that is meant to present the most important things about a drawing, such as pose, lighting**, background***, other...; it is when most of the changes can be made, such as changes to the pose****, background, lighting/light source etc.; For the sketch tiers please make sure that all of the important (not very quick and cosmetic) changes are accounted for in the concept sketch phase

5) **Actual sketch**: much lesser in quality than the sketch drawing tier but it'll show what the lineart will be based on; if the drawing is meant to be a sketch then after you accept the actual sketch I'll just clean it; for the flat colour and shaded tiers I won't be cleaning the sketch, as I will simply line the drawing instead

6) **Lineart**: the sketch is lined; when sent for feedback, the outer lines aren't thickened so that the adjustments can be made more easily

7) **Colouring**: I lay the base colours down; these can easily be changed even when the shading is added, as I do them on a separate layer; at this point the lines around characters should be thickened to help separate them from the background and/or each other

8) **Shading**: I add all the shadows, highlights, light sources and the background (if agreed upon in the initial consultation); I send the screenshot of the finished piece – if everything is alright then I add my watermark and send you the higher quality version (72 dpi, as exported) through either a google drive link or to your e-mail

9) **Posting**: After you receive the drawing I will be posting it online on my socials – this includes, but is not limited to: Furaffinity, Reddit and Twitter; I don't post commissions on e621 unless specifically requested by the commissioner; I don't post drawings immediately after finishing them, so I'd post your commission either on a Wednesday or a Saturday (or any day adjacent to either of these); You can either be credited for commissioning the piece (Commission for XYZ) or stay anonymous (Anonymous commission); **If you don't want me to post the commission you need to state it before the payment is sent, as this will affect the price**

You will receive a full-resolution, unglazed version of your commission but YOU MAY NOT POST IT PUBLICLY. THE ONLY VERSION YOU'RE ALLOWED TO POST IS THE GLAZED ONE

****it's only when lighting is integral to the piece or when the piece is meant to be dim-lit with a light source**

*****background will stay as a concept sketch for most of the drawing**

******not very drastic – a simple standing pose can't turn into an extreme perspective shot; aka you can't make changes that would affect the price**

Rules

1. You need to provide a clear visual reference (a drawing, a 3d model, anything that shows off the design and isn't obstructed by extreme shading); the reference needs to contain the colours of your character
2. My Turn-Around-Time is 3-5 weeks
3. You need to be responsive; I send regular WiPs and need feedback before moving onto the next stage
4. I take full payment upfront through Paypal
5. I don't offer refunds - unless:

- a. I literally can't work on the drawing for a prolonged period of time (e.g. my drawing tablet breaks and I can't buy a new one for another year)
 - b. I don't want to work on the drawing anymore - (There have been times when I would give a full refund due to not being skilled enough to work on the drawing)
- 6. I reserve the right to reject a commission for any reason
- 7. I can take on only a few commissions at a time (the number of slots in my twitter handle/discord status)
- 8. Even if my slots are full you can still contact me, you'll just be the next person in the queue
- 9. I don't always work on drawings chronologically - if I got a fully shaded commission as first and I get another sketch one that I can make in an hour then I'm most likely going to go for what's quicker and easier first; me doing sketch commissions doesn't slow down the drawing process for the more complex tiers
