- Presented the current situation in Noida
- A draft copy of the situation report prepared by Sphere India was presented
- 2. To understand the challenges at the local level and discuss solutions
- A massive fire broke out in the slum cluster of Sarfabad village in Noida Sector 74 on Sunday afternoon. Security agencies brought the fire under control and no casualty was reported in the incident.
- The fire broke out around 4 pm and seven fire engines rushed to the spot and doused the fire
- HCL along with its partner Agrogrami, Mamta and Rasta conducted a rapid assessment to assess
 the immediate needs of the affected people.
- The immediate needs are food, utensils and clothing.
- A local trust/ organization temporarily runs a community kitchen
- 3. Understanding and selecting volunteers on doing JRNA in flood affected areas
- Called for a list of volunteers from interested organizations for Joint Rapid Need Assessment in fire-affected areas so that all those volunteers can be trained on JRNA/Kobo collect app and prepare a report very soon
