

## Free Online Course for Traditional Undergraduate Students to OKWU

New and current students enrolling for Fall 2020 can take advantage of a free online course, offered during the summer and J-Term sessions.

# **FAQ for Free Online Course**

#### **Current Traditional Undergraduate Students:**

**Eligibility:** In order to receive a free, *3 credit online course*, you must be registered as a full-time student in Fall 2020 by:

- May 6th for Summer 2020 courses that begin in May 2020
- July 1st for Summer 2020 courses that begin in July 2020
- July 15th for the J-term courses that begin November 30th. You must also be enrolled in J-term courses by Oct. 31, 2020.

Enrolling: Login to WebAccess to enroll. You can select any course in Summer 2020.

#### **New Traditional Undergraduate Students:**

**Eligibility:** In order to receive a free 3 *credit online course*, you must be accepted and confirmed (Enrollment Commitment paid) by:

- May 6th for Summer 2020 courses that begin in May 2020
- July 1st for Summer 2020 courses that begin in July 2020
- July 15th for the J-term courses that begin November 30th. You must also be enrolled in J-term courses by Oct. 31, 2020.

**Enrolling:** Apply here or contact your Admissions Counselor for more information on eligibility and how to enroll. If you do not know who your counselor is, please email <a href="mailto:admissions@okwu.edu">admissions@okwu.edu</a>.

## **Program Details:**

- Tuition will be added to your student account.
- Enrollment will be verified after the last day to add courses, September 11, 2020.
- If your enrollment is confirmed, a \$450 scholarship will be applied and disbursed onto your account for Summer 2020.
- If your enrollment is not confirmed, you will be billed for the course.
- If you receive a Pell grant for your Summer courses (continuing students only), you can elect to take your free course in the 2020 J-term. Enroll no later than Oct. 31, 2020.

- The maximum scholarship will be \$450 which is the cost of 3 credits. If you take a course that is more than 3 credits, you will receive the \$450 scholarship towards your summer charges if other terms are met.
- Incoming students will be required to complete an Online Orientation prior to starting the course.
