You should remember that coals stay hot for as long as three days, so you must ensure that they are kept far away from flammable materials. #### Select The Wood

When you are setting up a fireplace, selecting the right type of wood is very important. Dense-quality wood works very well for fireplaces. It is imperative to split the wood into smaller pieces and preserve them in a dry area for a period of 5-6 months. Green woods like pine are not suitable for a wood burning fireplace as they produce a large amount of creosote. #### **Check The Condition of the Damper**

A damper is a plate that is movable in nature and is placed over the fireplace and before the flue. Before you set up the damper, you must check whether it is working properly or not. Checking the condition of the damper from time to time is one of the most important steps involved in maintaining a fireplace.

## Arrange The Logs

A lot of people feel a little confused about how one should arrange the logs in the fireplace. The 'triangle approach', that have been around for centuries is the most popular. Still, you can do things in a little more elaborate manner by positioning two logs on the opposite sides of the grate and putting two logs vertical to the base logs at the top.
