## No Justice No Peace hat pattern

Yarn: Worsted weight yarn- best to use acrylic yarn since that can be washed easily

Needle Size: Size 7 for ribbing, Size 8 for stockinette, size 9 for colorwork

Gauge: 18 sts == 4 ins in stockinette stitch on size 8 needles

If you size up or down, make sure to change all needles accordingly

Also, you may not need to size up for the colorwork section just make sure those stitches are loose so the can stretch around the head.

## Pattern:

Cast on 80 stitches with long-tail cast on. Place marker and join in the round.

Work in K1, P1 ribbing till it is 1" in length from cast-on edge.

Switch to size 8 needles. Work 3 rows in stockinette stitch.

Switch to size 9 needles and work the "NO PEACE" section of the colorwork pattern that is below.

Once that section is done, switch to size 8 needles and work 3 rows of stockinette stitch. Don't cut the alternate color yarn yet. Just carry up the work. Carry it up by twisting it over the main color at the start of every round.

Change back to size 9 needles and work "NO JUSTICE" section of colorwork pattern that is below.

Cut the alternate yarn color and leave a long enough tail to weave in the ends.

Once finished, switch back to size 8 needles and work in stockinette stitch till hat is 6" long from cast-on edge.

Now it is time to decrease for the crown:

Row 1: \*K2tog, K8 repeat from \* till end of row

Row 2: K across

Row 3: \*K2tog, K2 repeat from \* till end of row

Row 4: K across

Row 5: \*K2tog, K2 repeat from \* to last 2 stitches, K2tog

Row 6: K across

Row 7: \*K2tog, K2 repeat from \* till end of row

Row 8: K across


Row 9: \*K2tog, K2 repeat from \* to last 2 stitches, K2tog

Row 10: K across

Row 11: \*K2tog repeat from \* till end of row

Cut yarn leaving a long tail and put it through the live stitches making sure the top is closed up. Take that yarn into the inside of the hat and weave it in. Weave in all the other ends too.

## Congrats you have made hat! Go resist!



Each square is a stitch. The white square is the main color and the orange is the alternative. The arrows go all the way around the had so repeat that section fo the pattern till the end of the row. The blue marker is the stitch marker for the beginning of the row and the red squares are just to see how far to knit till starting the pattern [Don't knit those].
