TITLE 1 PARENT and Family Engagement POLICY

The Title 1 program at Marion Elementary School believes that the education of children requires a cooperative effort between families and the school. Your child's academic growth, as well as, social emotional well being, is greatly influenced by your involvement. This involvement includes understanding your child's strengths and weaknesses, attending parent meetings, conferences, family engagement events, and working with your child at home. We encourage you to be involved in the following ways:

- Attend the annual Title 1 meeting in the fall to learn about the Title 1 program and the rights of parents to be involved in the development, review and improvement of the Title 1 program as well as to elect parent representatives for our School Improvement Team and Superintendent Advisory Council.
- Participate in two way communication with the school and your child's teacher to ensure you stay informed of your child's progress. The school and classroom teacher will offer consistent communication with parents through Class Dojo, emails or phone calls. The school will offer flexible meetings and conferences throughout the school year either in person, by telephone, or home visits. Progress reports will be sent home every 4 ½ weeks and report cards every 9 weeks.
- School/Home Compacts will be jointly developed and signed by parents, school staff, and students describing the shared responsibility for student achievement.
- The Marion Elementary Title 1 Program will plan and implement family engagement activities throughout the school year such as reading, science, or math nights.

The faculty and staff at Marion Elementary will make every effort to provide equal opportunities for the participation of all families.. This includes, but is not limited to, families with limited English proficiency, families with disabilities, and families of migratory children. This includes providing information in a language and format families can understand and home visits if needed.
