<b>Agenda</b>  Welcome  Proposal 1- Waiver Days <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Summary: Proposing for 3 additional Waiver Days</li><li>- Rationale: In a traditional school year, Nimitz Elementary School was able to provide teacher collaboration during the school day. However, due to a substitute teaching shortage and the need to remain in the classroom for so many students with learning loss, NES teachers were not able to collaborate as frequently. Also, with the loss of the 21 Hours of Professional Development, time at the end of the workday was also lost to fill that gap. Stipend days have been considered as well, but stipend days are still optional and require a significant fiscal commitment that NES may not be able to sustain due to declining enrollment.</li><li>- Pros: With a new emphasis on multi-tiered systems of support, it is imperative teachers have time to analyze data, develop differentiated instructional practices, and collaborate on different approaches to curriculum, instruction, and assessment. As Nimitz ES Math scores have faltered, we will need to implement a new Math curriculum which will require time and a new understanding of our approach to Math instruction.
