OPTIONAL: Hydroponics 101 - *Hydroponics in Your Classroom* (PDE) \$40

During the training, teachers will receive an overview of Green Our Planet's Hydroponics Curriculum. They will dive deeper into the NGSS aligned lessons in grade level breakout sessions.

This course also covers how to germinate seeds, transplant seedlings, and how to properly maintain and troubleshoot a hydroponic system. Teachers will learn how to harvest and how to utilize that harvest with farmers' markets, chef demos, and/or salad bars.

The training will take place over 3 (2.5 hour) sessions:

Session 1: Wednesday, February 8, 2023, 4:30 PM-7:00 PM PDT

Session 2: Wednesday, February 15, 2023, 4:30 PM-7:00 PM PDT

Session 3: Wednesday, February 22, 2023, 4:30 PM-7:00 PM PDT
