

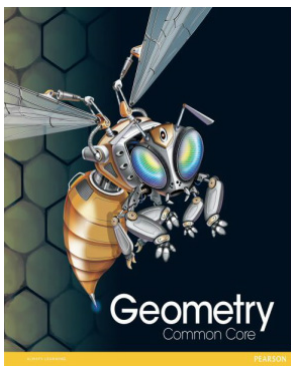
Honors Geometry

Dear Parents and Students,

The decision to be in Honors Geometry at EHS is a serious one. The work in this class will require exemplary work habits and time management skills due to the rigor of the concepts and fast pace. Students are expected to have a genuine desire to learn and the self-discipline and determination to succeed in the EHS honors math program. Remember, your high school math courses are cumulative. This means that you will need to utilize concepts previously learned to apply them to future courses. This summer review is to reacquaint you with necessary Algebra skills to be successful in Honors Geometry.

Most of these problems do not require a calculator. You are allowed to use a calculator on any of the word problems. I suggest the TI-84 Plus CE graphing calculator. An answer key is provided for most of the problems, so be sure to check your answers.

Pace yourself and start early on this summer review packet! By doing about just a few problems a WEEK, you should be able to complete it by the first day of school in August.
