We commit to implementing all components of literacy instruction while providing Tier 1 instruction so that students will have the optimum amount of instructional time with Tier 1 and Tier 2 or 3 when necessary.

Action Steps:

- Grade-level teams will collaboratively plan with ELD and special education teachers to align instruction, analyze data, and ensure consistent, standards-based, differentiated literacy instruction.
- Use literacy walkthrough tools to assess the fidelity of implementation of literacy instruction.
- Use entrance and exit criteria to identify students who need Tier 2 and 3 support
- Include Multilingual Learner (ML) English language proficiency levels as part of instructional decision making.

Mathematics Strategy:

Engaging students in mathematics learning that fosters student agency and self-efficacy

Statement of Commitment:

We commit to meaningfully engaging students in mathematics learning that fosters student agency and self-

efficacy so that students will develop productive learning behaviors and dispositions that support their understanding and mastery of content.

Action Steps:

- Ensure students make sense of the mathematics throughout the lesson by:
 - o Collaboratively planning and PL
 - Engaging in mathematics before explicit instruction takes place
 - Selecting and sequencing student work
 - Opportunities for students to analyze and critique work of their peers
- Build positive math identity

Statement of Commitment:

We commit to engaging in regular attendance meetings and in timely communication with families regarding student attendance so that each student and family will be more informed about their own student's attendance and system policy.

Action Steps:

- Engaging students and families in the understanding of the importance of attendance.
- Staff outreach to build positive connection (welcoming phone calls, calls of care and concern, individualized communication).
- Weekly attendance monitoring and outreach.
- Developing attendance plans with chronically absent students / families.

Discipline Strategy:

Creating a positive and restorative school culture that prioritizes healthy relationships and grows a culture of belonging for all students.

Statement of Commitment:

At JHES, we commit to creating a positive school culture that prioritizes healthy relationships and grows a culture of belonging so that students will experience less exclusionary discipline as evidenced by overall suspension rates.

Action Steps:

- Implementation of school culture and climate initiatives with a focus on belonging, relationships, cultural responsiveness with dignity, respect, & mutual concern (PBIS, SEL, trauma-informed strategies, and the Zones of Regulation).
- Professional learning and implementation of trauma responsive strategies.
