Key Camp Details

Staffing: All staff members are certified in CPR and First Aid, have undergone criminal background checks, and have experience working with school-age children.

Ages: The camp is designed for children aged 2 to 11 years old and meets the developmental needs of this age group.

Morning Camp Time: 9:00 AM – 12:45 PM

- Carpool Line/ Please do not get out of the car
- The school will provide a morning snack

Extended Care:

- Early care: 8:30 AM – 9:00 AM. Please bring your child to the school entrance.

- Aftercare: 12:45 PM – 2:45 PM. Please pick up your child at the school entrance and bring a snack for the afternoon.
- A late fee of \$1 per minute applies for pickups after extended care has ended.

Full-Time Camp: 8:30 am to 4:30 pm.

- Please drop off and pick up your child at the school entrance
- The school will provide a morning snack. Please bring an extra snack for the afternoon
- A late fee of \$1 per minute applies for pickups after extended care has ended

Drop-Off and Pick-Up Procedures half Day, 9:00 am to 12:45 pm

Drop-Off:

- Begins at 8:55 AM. Please follow the one-way circular driveway.
- Pull up beside the tree, and a counselor will walk your child to the entrance.
- Wait for a signal before moving forward.

Pick-Up:

- Starts at 12:35 PM and ends at 12:45 PM.
- Pull up beside the orange cone, and a counselor will bring your child to your vehicle.
- A \$25 after-care fee will be applied for pick-ups after 12:50 PM, regardless of the duration of the stay.

Photo ID: If someone other than you is picking up your child, they must present a valid photo ID to ensure the child's safety.

Water Days

Tuesdays and Thursdays are water days! Please make sure your camper is prepared: (summer camps)

- Wear a rash guard, swim trunks, or fast-drying clothing.
- Bring a labeled towel.
- Apply sunscreen and mosquito repellent before drop-off.

What to Bring

- Lunch: A healthy, peanut-free, non-refrigerated, non-microwavable lunch.
- Snack: Provided by the school. If your child requires a specific diet, please send their snack.
- Afternoon campers, please bring an extra snack
- Water Bottle: Labeled and preferably frozen overnight for a cool drink throughout the day.
- Towel: Labeled
- Medication: If required, send it in a labeled backpack along with a signed medication form.
- **Campers who wear diapers must bring wipes, extra diapers, and a change of clothes.**

What Not to Bring

We are not responsible for lost or stolen items. Please do not send:

- Toys
- Money
- Valuables

What to Wear

- Play clothes or quick-dry clothing.
- Closed-toe shoes.
- Weather-appropriate attire.
