1. Run at speed to the far end of the arena past the end marker and do a left rollback—no hesitation.
2. Run to the opposite end of the arena past the end marker and do a right rollback—no hesitation.
3. Run past the center marker and do a sliding stop. Back up to center of the arena or at least ten feet (three meters). Hesitate.
4. Complete four spins to the right. Hesitate.
5. Complete four and one-quarter spins to the left so that horse is facing left wall or fence. Hesitate.
6. Beginning on the left lead, complete three circles to the left: the first circle large and fast; the second circle small and slow; the third circle large and fast. Change leads at the center of the arena.
7. Complete three circles to the right: the first circle large and fast; the second circle small and slow; the third circle large and fast. Change leads at the center of the arena.
8. Begin a large circle to the left but do not close this circle. Run straight up the right side of the arena past the center marker and do a sliding stop at least twenty feet (six meters) from wall or fence. Hesitate to demonstrate the completion of the pattern.

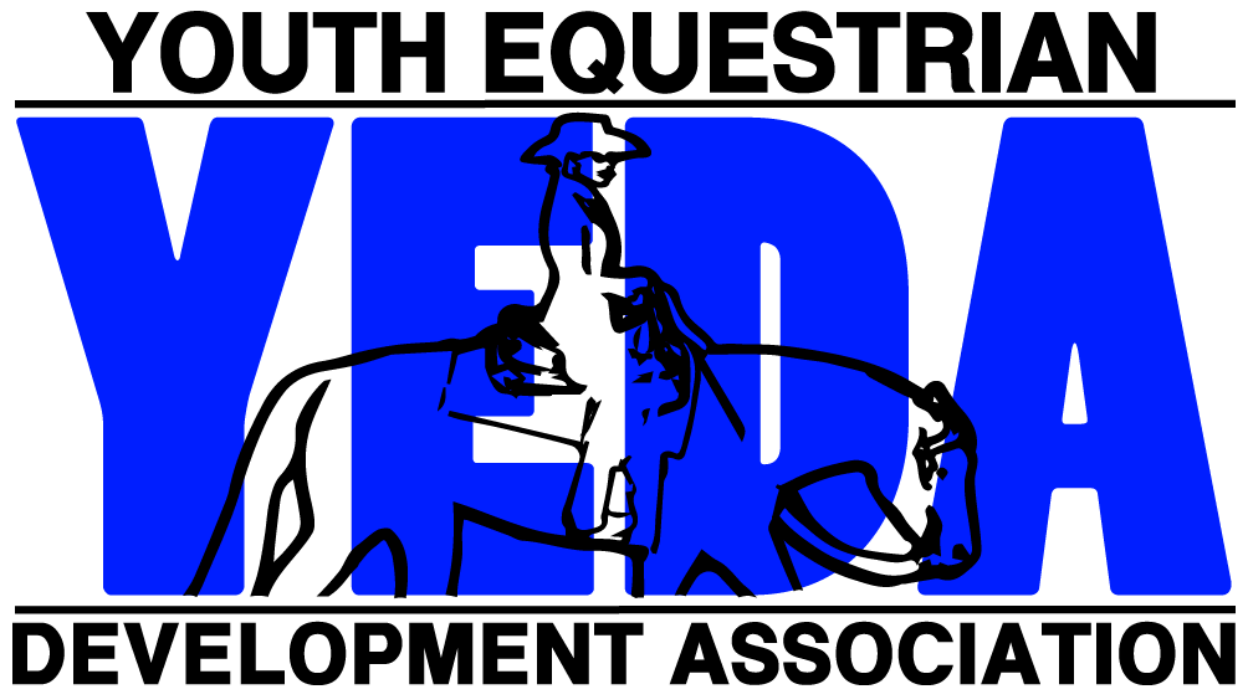
Horse Descriptions

1. **Capri** (Champion Hill) – Has a spur stop, so squeeze to slow. Do not over que, use voice first. Very responsive. Keep outside leg on at the lope. No spurs.
2. **Hope** (Champion Hill) – Lesson type horse. Do not over que. Will drop in at the lope, keep outside leg on her to set up for leads. Ball spurs only.
3. **Joey** (Champion Hill) – Spur stop trained. Go to leg for turns. Keep in bridle. Sit quiet or will speed up with seat. Ball spurs only.
4. **GiGi** (Concord) – Bay mare. Very straight forward and EASY to ride. Pull and release to keep her slow, use your legs as well. Does not take much leg, but you need to keep her together at the lope. No crop or spurs.
5. **Reggie** (Concord) – Bay gelding. Very kind, get excited but very good at all maneuvers. Not a big stopper, so do not run hard to the stops. Two hand option, ball spurs.
6. **Cowboy** (Concord) – Paint chestnut gelding. Takes a lot of leg to hand to keep him rounded up. Can go slow if you keep him round. Flyng lead change, don't trap him up in his turn around otherwise he will back up. Division appropriate spurs.
7. **Georgie** (Cornerhouse) – Nice quiet draw. Soft leg and hand. Cluck to jog and kiss to lope. Do not over bridle but have some contact. No crop and no spurs.
8. **Nick** (Cornerhouse) – Do not over bridle. Old show horse; knows his job. Keep him on the rail. Use your voice. Cluck to jog and kiss to lope. Watch leads. No spurs.
9. **Riley** (Cornerhouse) – Have contact. Do not clamp your legs, he will go faster. Cluck to jog and kiss to lope. Set up for right lead. Likes to back crooked but can be corrected with legs. No spurs.
10. **Sweet** (Cornerhouse) – Have contact. Listens to vocals. Cluck to jog and kiss to lope. Watch leads. She will jog and lope but will build speed if rider allows her. Two hand option. No spurs.
11. **Riley** (EQD) – Sorrel QH Gelding. Light rein contact. Soft legs. If he wants to go slow, let him. Don't be pushy. - Soft cues for leads and pattern work. Soft legs for jog transition, soft consistent push for lope. Division appropriate spurs, but don't overuse them.
12. **Rose** (EQD) – Bay QH mare. Is super sensitive to all hand/leg/voice cues. Maintain rein contact and adjust as needed. Is spur broke and will stop in gaits if over touched with hand and too much leg is used. Soft legs for jog transition, soft consistent push for lope Has a spur stop, but NO spurs or crop..
13. **Dawg** (Puthoff) –Reiner/ranch horse. So feet off to stop and slow down. Kiss for lead changes and spins. No spur generally, ball spur or dull rowel only if okayed by me.
14. **George** (Puthoff) –Some rein contact and is spur stop trained. Ball or dull spur.
15. **Zip** (Puthoff) – Very lazy. Can do ranch also. But very lazy for lead change. Crop option for walk trot. Be sure to set him up for right lead. Spur appropriate for all other divisions.

16. **Amos** (Royal Creek) - Ride with some contact with reins, use hand to slow, cluck to jog. Very simple. No spurs.
17. **Ozzie** (Royal Creek) – Retired show horse. Babysitter; great draw. Cluck to trot, kiss to lope. Works off of leg pressure to pivot – division appropriate spurs if needed. Very easy to ride. Walk/trot deluxe.
18. **Rosie** (Royal Creek) - Sorrel mare. Great draw; retired show horse. Walk/trot deluxe. Division appropriate spurs if needed. Not tight rein and don't gouge with the spur. Sweet mare.
19. **Jett** (Royal Creek) - Bay gelding QH. Retired show horse. Babysitter; great draw. Cluck to trot, kiss to lope. Works off of leg pressure to pivot – division appropriate spurs if needed. Very easy to ride. Walk/trot deluxe.
20. **Obie** (Royal Creek) - Straight forward. Can get heavy on forehand, ride him from your leg to your hand. Keep collected On a light rein. Enjoy! Great Draw! Yes to crop and ball spurs only!
21. **Jimmie** (Royal Creek) - Reiner - Great draw! Ride leg to hand, lift hand into lope transitions (can be lazy), soft spur through flying change, does not have a big stop. Rail/pattern: Sit heavy, keep a quiet seat, do not rush into maneuvers, give and take to stay slow and collected No Spurs 2 HANDS
22. **Charlie** (Royal Creek) - great draw division appropriate ball spurs. Does not need tight rein, click to trot , smooth to lope.
23. **Harlee** (Royal Creek) – Palamino gelding. Reiner & ranch type. Gets a bit nervous standing in the middle but settles into the pattern. 2 hand option.
24. **Mya** (Royal Creek) - Ride leg to hand, very light contact in hand, sit heavy. No crop, no spur no pattern.
25. **Tex** (Royal Creek) – Simple draw. Cluck to jog, kiss to lope. Use leg and rein to pivot. Hold light pressure in hand during extended jog.
26. **Jose** (Royal Creek) – Bay gelding, gentle giant. Walk trot only. Retired show horse; perfect in every way. Cluck to trot. Amazing draw. Walk/trot deluxe.
27. **Collin** (Royal Creek) – Ride leg to hand (soft aids). Lift hand and set up for leads. Steer with leg and hand, use vocal cues and spur stop. Ball spurs only.
28. **Laredo** (Royal Creek) – Paint gelding. Sweet horse; retired show horse. Babysitter; great draw. Cluck to trot, kiss to lope. Works off of leg pressure to pivot – division appropriate spurs if needed. Very easy to ride. Walk/trot deluxe.
29. **Ali** (Southern Ohio) - Bay QH, Maintain rein contact, but not super tight; give and take with leg pressure; cluck for jog, kiss for lope, setup for leads. 2 hand option for patterns; fine with neck rain for rail. Check back and release with leg pressure to slow at trot. Kiss and use leg pressure to keep in lope. Spurs according to division.
30. **Coco** (Southern Ohio) - Bay QH Gelding. Use quiet hands & consistent, but light contact. He will pull against the bit if reins are too short or if you pull on his face. Responds to voice commands. Cluck & wave legs for jog. If you cue to aggressively or kick for jog, you will get a long trot. Kiss and outside leg pressure for lope. Responds best to easy/light legs/cues. Will respond to spur stop or neck rein. Spurs can be used to slow, collect, or set head, and can be used according to division. However, spurs not recommended for riders not familiar with

spur-trained horses, as you will not need spurs for forward motion and if they are used in that way, you will not get your best ride. He has very slow jog and lope with correct use of spurs or no spurs, but will move out with a (very safe, but faster) hunt seat stride with overuse of spurs or more aggressive cues

31. **Boone** (Southern Ohio) – Can have more rein contact in divisions with no spurs; check back and release for slower jog; use voice commands along with cluck for jog, kiss for lope; maintain forward motion for flying lead change; lift reins, slight pull and squeeze for back, but release contact with verbal whoa to stop, or he will continue backing. Lift reins; use body and outside leg for turns and spins (use leg just before moving hand(s) left or right). Neck reins well, but two-hand (option) may be preferred for more difficult patterns and/or Ranch Riding.
32. **Jett** (Southern Ohio) - Black QH gelding. Light rein contact and LOTS of leg/spur. If contact is too tight, he won't move forward. Use spurs according to division and if none are allowed, a crop is permitted. Cluck & kick for jog; Kiss & cue for lope. Increase forward motion for flying lead change. Can be very lazy but does very well with a confident rider not afraid to use legs or spurs. Continue kissing and consistent leg contact through lope if he gets too slow/uncollected. Use inside leg and body position to keep him from cutting corners in rail work.
33. **Lexi** (Southern Ohio) – Bay QH/Paint mare. Cluck to jog, kiss to lope. Support with leg/calf pressure, particularly at the lope. 2 hand option, division appropriate spurs.
34. **Diva** (Southern Ohio) - Super slow, cluck for the jog. Voice commands “whoa” and “easy”. Sit deep in the saddle. Keep hands low and quiet. Squeeze and say “back” to back. Can lift up a bit to back and/or stop (along with voice command), but don't need to pull back. As little bit/face contact as possible
35. **T** (Southern Ohio) - Palomino QH Gelding. Ranch type. Responds best to voice commands. Hum and sit deep and release legs to slow a Lots of leg pressure to speed up (can be lazy). Cluck and kick for jog/trot. Kiss and cue for lope. Say Whoa, sit deep and release legs to stop. Less likely to break in extended trot if you post vs stand. Prefers a looser rein, but can be taken in for horsemanship patterns. Spurs according to division.

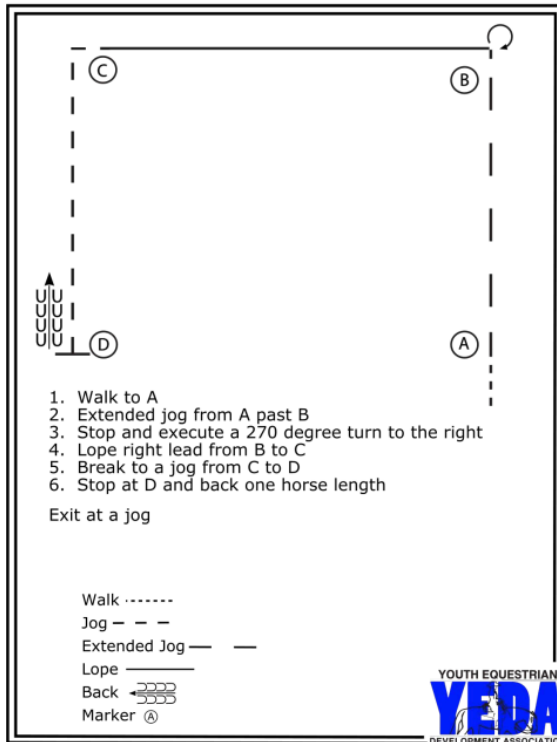
Pearl/Opal Pattern 2



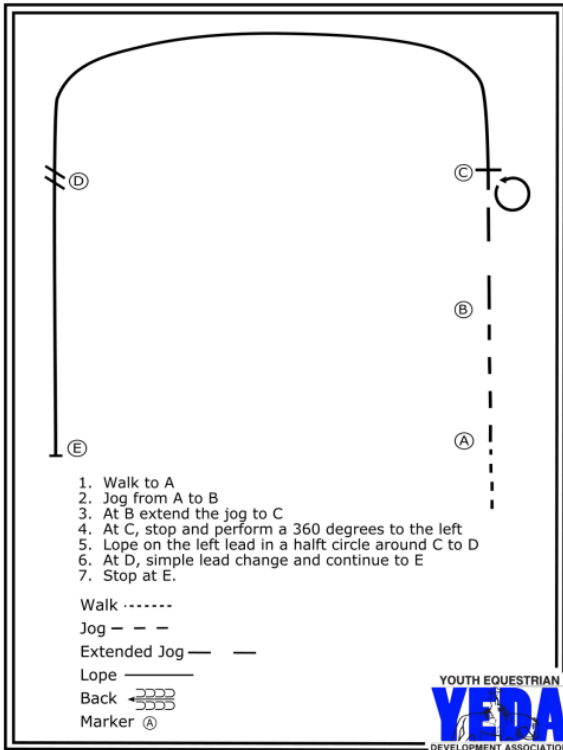
Emerald Pattern 2



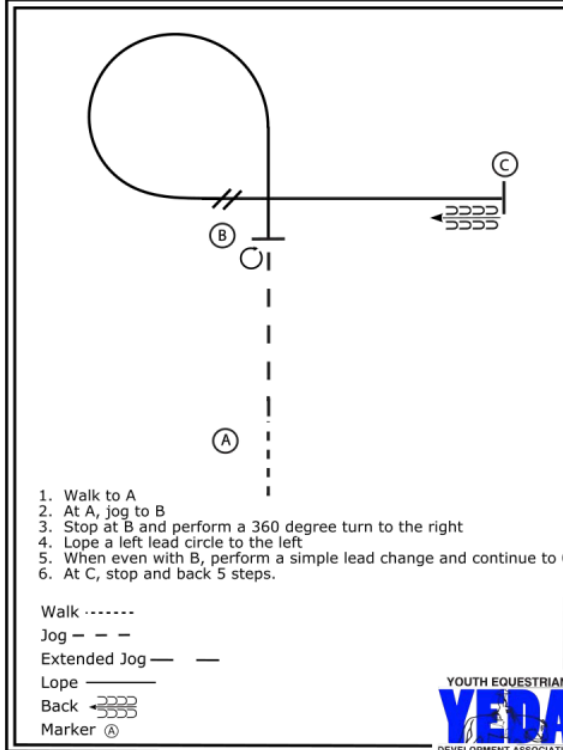

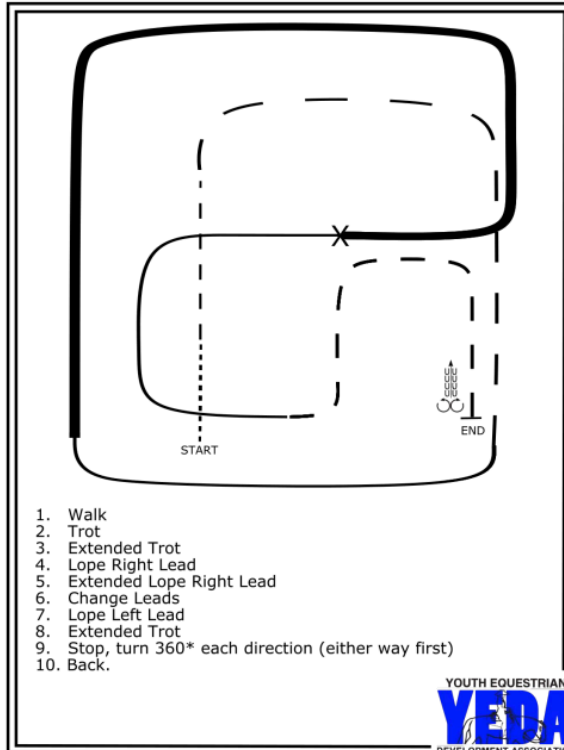
Sapphire/Alumni Pattern 2



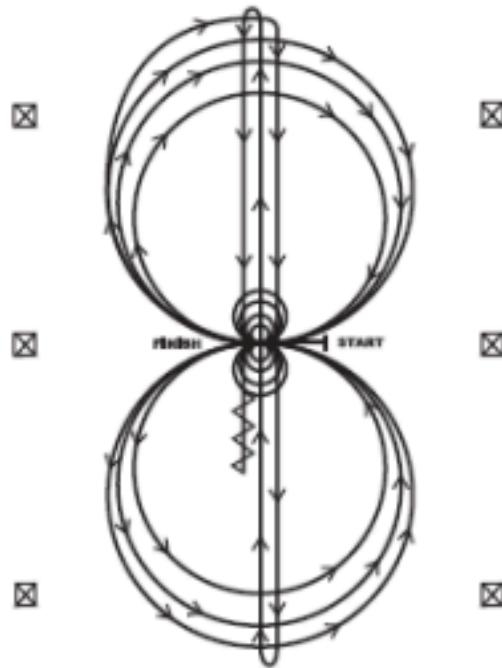
Diamond Pattern 2

NRHA Pattern 2



Horses may walk or jog to the center of arena. Horses must walk or stop prior to starting pattern. Beginning at the center of the arena facing the left wall or fence.

1. Beginning on the right lead, complete three circles to the right: the first circle small and slow; the next two circles large and fast. Change leads at the center of the arena.
2. Complete three circles to the left: the first circle small and slow; the next two circles large and fast. Change leads at the center of the arena.
3. Continue around previous circle to the right. At the top of the circle, run down the middle to the far end of the arena past the end marker and do a right rollback—no hesitation.
4. Run up the middle to the opposite end of the arena past the end marker and do a left rollback—no hesitation.
5. Run past the center marker and do a sliding stop. Backup to the center of the arena or at least ten feet (threemeters). Hesitate.
6. Complete four spins to the right. Hesitate.
7. Complete four spins to the left. Hesitate to demonstrate the completion of the pattern.

Horse Descriptions

1. **Capri** (Champion Hill) – Has a spur stop, so squeeze to slow. Do not over que, use voice first. Very responsive. Keep outside leg on at the lope. No spurs.
2. **Hope** (Champion Hill) – Lesson type horse. Do not over que. Will drop in at the lope, keep outside leg on her to set up for leads. Ball spurs only.
3. **Joey** (Champion Hill) – Spur stop trained. Go to leg for turns. Keep in bridle. Sit quiet or will speed up with seat. Ball spurs only.
4. **GiGi** (Concord) – Bay mare. Very straight forward and EASY to ride. Pull and release to keep her slow, use your legs as well. Does not take much leg, but you need to keep her together at the lope. No crop or spurs.
5. **Reggie** (Concord) – Bay gelding. Very kind, get excited but very good at all maneuvers. Not a big stopper, so do not run hard to the stops. Two hand option, ball spurs.
6. **Cowboy** (Concord) – Paint chestnut gelding. Takes a lot of leg to hand to keep him rounded up. Can go slow if you keep him round. Flyng lead change, don't trap him up in his turn around otherwise he will back up. Division appropriate spurs.
7. **Georgie** (Cornerhouse) – Nice quiet draw. Soft leg and hand. Cluck to jog and kiss to lope. Do not over bridle but have some contact. No crop and no spurs.
8. **Nick** (Cornerhouse) – Do not over bridle. Old show horse; knows his job. Keep him on the rail. Use your voice. Cluck to jog and kiss to lope. Watch leads. No spurs.
9. **Riley** (Cornerhouse) – Have contact. Do not clamp your legs, he will go faster. Cluck to jog and kiss to lope. Set up for right lead. Likes to back crooked but can be corrected with legs. No spurs.
10. **Sweet** (Cornerhouse) – Have contact. Listens to vocals. Cluck to jog and kiss to lope. Watch leads. She will jog and lope but will build speed if rider allows her. Two hand option. No spurs.
11. **Riley** (EQD) – Sorrel QH Gelding. Light rein contact. Soft legs. If he wants to go slow, let him. Don't be pushy. - Soft cues for leads and pattern work. Soft legs for jog transition, soft consistent push for lope. Division appropriate spurs, but don't overuse them.
12. **Rose** (EQD) – Bay QH mare. Is super sensitive to all hand/leg/voice cues. Maintain rein contact and adjust as needed. Is spur broke and will stop in gaits if over touched with hand and too much leg is used. Soft legs for jog transition, soft consistent push for lope Has a spur stop, but NO spurs or crop..
13. **Dawg** (Puthoff) –Reiner/ranch horse. So feet off to stop and slow down. Kiss for lead changes and spins. No spur generally, ball spur or dull rowel only if okayed by me.
14. **George** (Puthoff) –Some rein contact and is spur stop trained. Ball or dull spur.
15. **Zip** (Puthoff) – Very lazy. Can do ranch also. But very lazy for lead change. Crop option for walk trot. Be sure to set him up for right lead. Spur appropriate for all other divisions.

16. **Ozzie** (Royal Creek) – Retired show horse. Babysitter; great draw. Cluck to trot, kiss to lope. Works off of leg pressure to pivot – division appropriate spurs if needed. Very easy to ride. Walk/trot deluxe.
17. **Rosie** (Royal Creek) - Sorrel mare. Great draw; retired show horse. Walk/trot deluxe. Division appropriate spurs if needed. Not tight rein and don't gouge with the spur. Sweet mare.
18. **Jett** (Royal Creek) - Bay gelding QH. Retired show horse. Babysitter; great draw. Cluck to trot, kiss to lope. Works off of leg pressure to pivot – division appropriate spurs if needed. Very easy to ride. Walk/trot deluxe.
19. **Obie** (Royal Creek) - Straight forward. Can get heavy on forehand, ride him from your leg to your hand. Keep collected On a light rein. Enjoy! Great Draw! Yes to crop and ball spurs only!
20. **Jimmie** (Royal Creek) - Reiner - Great draw! Ride leg to hand, lift hand into lope transitions (can be lazy), soft spur through flying change, does not have a big stop. Rail/pattern: Sit heavy, keep a quiet seat, do not rush into maneuvers, give and take to stay slow and collected No Spurs 2 HANDS
21. **Charlie** (Royal Creek) - great draw division appropriate ball spurs. Does not need tight rein, click to trot , smooth to lope.
22. **Harlee** (Royal Creek) – Palamino gelding. Reiner & ranch type. Gets a bit nervous standing in the middle but settles into the pattern. 2 hand option.
23. **Mya** (Royal Creek) - Ride leg to hand, very light contact in hand, sit heavy. No crop, no spur no pattern.
24. **Tex** (Royal Creek) – Simple draw. Cluck to jog, kiss to lope. Use leg and rein to pivot. Hold light pressure in hand during extended jog.
25. **Jose** (Royal Creek) – Bay gelding, gentle giant. Walk trot only. Retired show horse; perfect in every way. Cluck to trot. Amazing draw. Walk/trot deluxe.
26. **Collin** (Royal Creek) – Ride leg to hand (soft aids). Lift hand and set up for leads. Steer with leg and hand, use vocal cues and spur stop. Ball spurs only.
27. **Laredo** (Royal Creek) – Paint gelding. Sweet horse; retired show horse. Babysitter; great draw. Cluck to trot, kiss to lope. Works off of leg pressure to pivot – division appropriate spurs if needed. Very easy to ride. Walk/trot deluxe.
28. **Ali** (Southern Ohio) - Bay QH, Maintain rein contact, but not super tight; give and take with leg pressure; cluck for jog, kiss for lope, setup for leads. 2 hand option for patterns; fine with neck rain for rail. Check back and release with leg pressure to slow at trot. Kiss and use leg pressure to keep in lope. Spurs according to division.
29. **Coco** (Southern Ohio) - Bay QH Gelding. Use quiet hands & consistent, but light contact. He will pull against the bit if reins are too short or if you pull on his face. Responds to voice commands. Cluck & wave legs for jog. If you cue to aggressively or kick for jog, you will get a long trot. Kiss and outside leg pressure for lope. Responds best to easy/light legs/cues. Will respond to spur stop or neck rein. Spurs can be used to slow, collect, or set head, and can be used according to division. However, spurs not recommended for riders not familiar with spur-trained horses, as you will not need spurs for forward motion and if they are used in that way, you will not get your best ride. He has very slow jog and lope

- with correct use of spurs or no spurs, but will move out with a (very safe, but faster) hunt seat stride with overuse of spurs or more aggressive cues
30. **Boone** (Southern Ohio) – Can have more rein contact in divisions with no spurs; check back and release for slower jog; use voice commands along with cluck for jog, kiss for lope; maintain forward motion for flying lead change; lift reins, slight pull and squeeze for back, but release contact with verbal whoa to stop, or he will continue backing. Lift reins; use body and outside leg for turns and spins (use leg just before moving hand(s) left or right). Neck reins well, but two-hand (option) may be preferred for more difficult patterns and/or Ranch Riding.
 31. **Jett** (Southern Ohio) - Black QH gelding. Light rein contact and LOTS of leg/spur. If contact is too tight, he won't move forward. Use spurs according to division and if none are allowed, a crop is permitted. Cluck & kick for jog; Kiss & cue for lope. Increase forward motion for flying lead change. Can be very lazy but does very well with a confident rider not afraid to use legs or spurs. Continue kissing and consistent leg contact through lope if he gets too slow/uncollected. Use inside leg and body position to keep him from cutting corners in rail work.
 32. **Lexi** (Southern Ohio) – Bay QH/Paint mare. Cluck to jog, kiss to lope. Support with leg/calf pressure, particularly at the lope. 2 hand option, division appropriate spurs.
 33. **Diva** (Southern Ohio) - Super slow, cluck for the jog. Voice commands “whoa” and “easy”. Sit deep in the saddle. Keep hands low and quiet. Squeeze and say “back” to back. Can lift up a bit to back and/or stop (along with voice command), but don't need to pull back. As little bit/face contact as possible
 34. **T** (Southern Ohio) - Palomino QH Gelding. Ranch type. Responds best to voice commands. Hum and sit deep and release legs to slow a Lots of leg pressure to speed up (can be lazy). Cluck and kick for jog/trot. Kiss and cue for lope. Say Whoa, sit deep and release legs to stop. Less likely to break in extended trot if you post vs stand. Prefers a looser rein, but can be taken in for horsemanship patterns. Spurs according to division.
